The plural of a noun is usually -s:

singular (= one) → plural (= two or more)

a flower → some flowers

a train → two trains

one week → a few weeks

a nice place → some nice places this student → these students

a flower

B These things are plural in English:



- Do you wear glasses?
- Where are the scissors? I need them.

You can also say a pair of scissors / a pair of pants / a pair of pajamas, etc.:

I need a new pair of jeans. or I need some new jeans. (not a new jeans)

Some plurals do not end in -s:

this man → these men one foot → two feet that sheep → those sheep a woman → some women a tooth → all my teeth a fish → a lot of fish a mouse → some mice

also a person - two people / some people / a lot of people, etc.:

- She's a nice person.
- but They are nice people. (not nice persons)

D

People is plural (= they), so we say people are / people have, etc.:

- A lot of people speak English. (not speaks)
- I like the people here. They are very friendly.

Police is plural:

The police want to talk to anybody who saw the accident. (not The police wants)
