(go) to school, (be) at school, start school, finish school, etc.

- What did you learn at school today? (not at the school)
- Some children don't like school.

(go) to college, (be) in college

- tly prohibited Helen wants to go to college when she finishes high school.
- What did you study in college?

(go) to class, (be) in class

- I can't talk now. I have to go to class.
- I'll be in class until 5:00 today. I'll call you when I get out.

(go) to prison/jail, (be) in prison/jail

- Why is he in prison? What did he do?
- (go) to church, (be) in/at church
  - David usually goes to church on Sundays.

(go) to bed, (be) in bed

- I'm tired. I'm going to bed. (not to the bed)
- Where's Jane?" "She's in bed."

(go) home, (be) (at) home, etc.

- I'm tired. I'm going home. (not to home)
- Are you going out tonight, or are you staying home? (or staying at home)

> (go to) the movies / the theater / the bank / the post office / the hospital / the station / the airport

- I never go to the theater, but I go to the movies a lot.
- "Are you going to the bank?" "No, to the post office."
- The number 5 bus goes to the airport; the number 8 goes to the train station.
