
not + any no none

The parking lot is empty.

There aren't any cars in the parking lot.

There are no cars

How many cars are there in the parking lot?
None.

prohibited

not (-n't) + any

- There aren't any cars in the parking lot.
- Tracey and Jeff don't have any children.
- You can have some coffee, but I don't want any.

no + noun (no cars / no garage, etc.)

no ... = not any or not a

- There are no cars in the parking lot. (= there aren't any cars)
- We have no coffee. (= we don't have any coffee)
- It's a nice house, but there's no garage. (= there isn't a garage)

We use no . . . especially after have/has and there is/are.

negative verb + any = positive verb + no

- They don't have any children. or They have no children. (not They don't have no children)
- There isn't any sugar in your coffee. or There's no sugar in your coffee.

No and none

Use no + noun (no money / no children, etc.):

- We have no money.
- Everything was OK. There were no problems.

Use none alone (without a noun):

- "How much money do you have?" "None." (= no money)
- "Were there any problems?" "No, none." (= no problems)

None and no one

None is an answer for How much? / How many? (things or people):

- "How much money do you have?" "None." (= no money)
- "How many people did you meet?" "None." (= no people)

No one is an answer for Who?:

Who did you meet?" "No one." or "Nobody."
