
# Man Tries to Turn Over a New Leaf

7Grant High School was the school that Backman attended 13 years earlier. He wanted to turn over a new leaf. "I was trying to return to a time when I was not a criminal, to start again, to get a scholarship and go to college," he told police. 8Backman is now behind bars for his new crime as well as his old ones.


