Guide to Reading

This section consists of three sections, each with its own directions and format:

Part V: Sentence Completion 40 items
Part VI: Error Identification 20 items
Part VII: Short Passages 40 items

Although ETS calls this section "Reading," only Part VII actually tests reading skills. Parts V and VI test your knowledge of grammar, usage, and vocabulary.

Timing is an important factor in the second section. Your goal is to finish all the items and leave yourself a few minutes to go back to items that you found difficult.

Part VII is the most time consuming because it takes time to read the passages. You may be able to go through the items in Parts V and VI quickly, but you don't want to go so fast that you make simple mistakes. You may work on these parts in any order that you want. You may want to begin with Part VII before working on Part V or Part VI.

This part of the Guide is divided into three lessons, each concerning one part of the test. These lessons familiarize you with the kinds of problems you will encounter on the test and provide exercises to prepare you for each type of problem.
