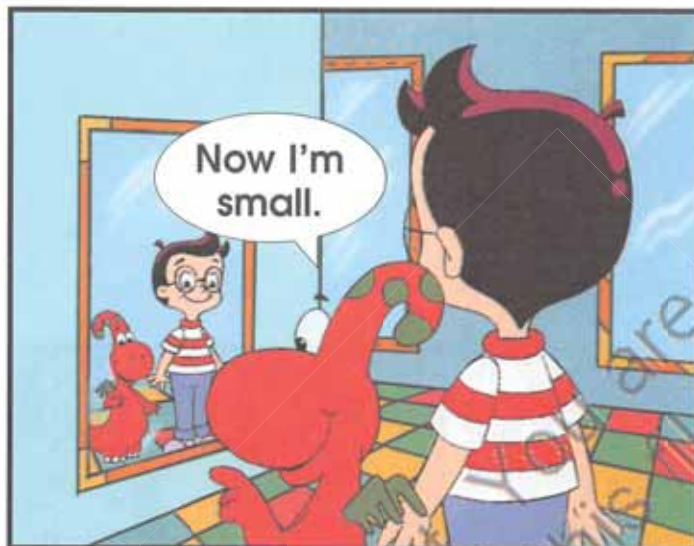
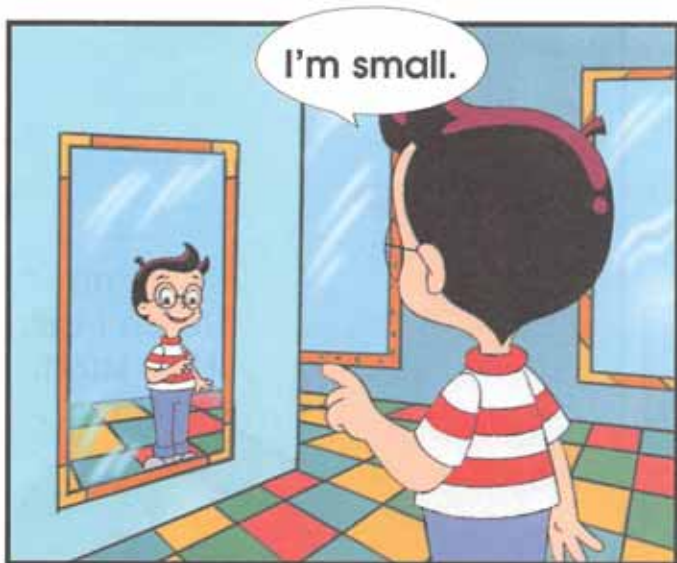
Gogo and his friends are at the fair.



Gogo goes into the House of Mirrors.

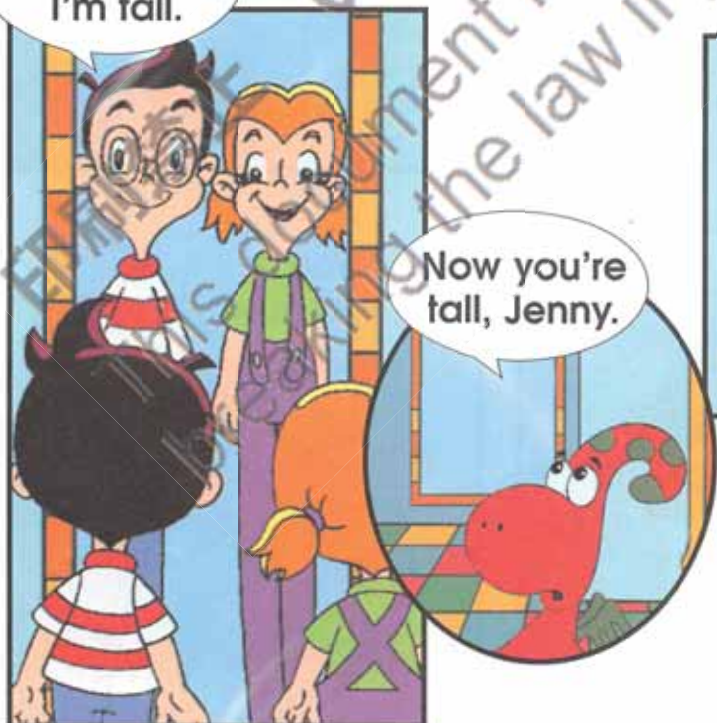




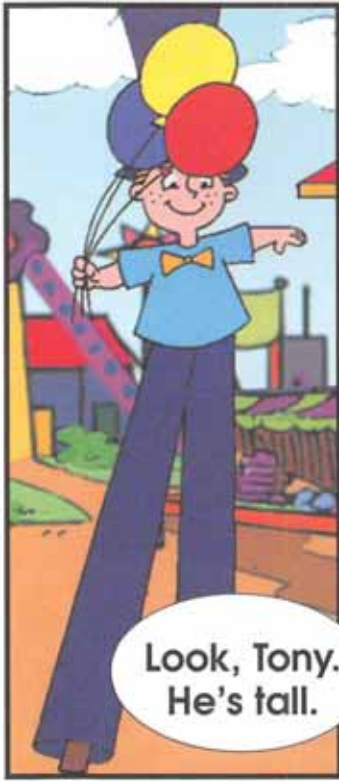


That's right, Gogo. She's big.

Oh, look! Come on.



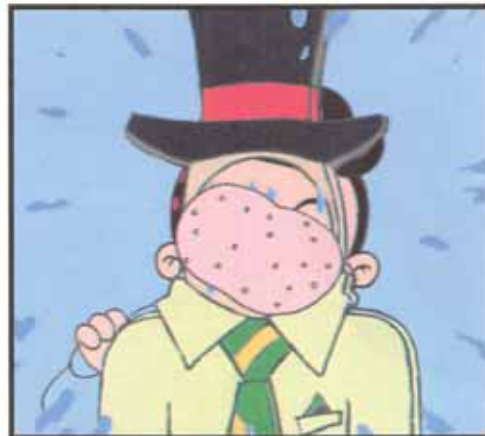
You can't throw.

throw, too.



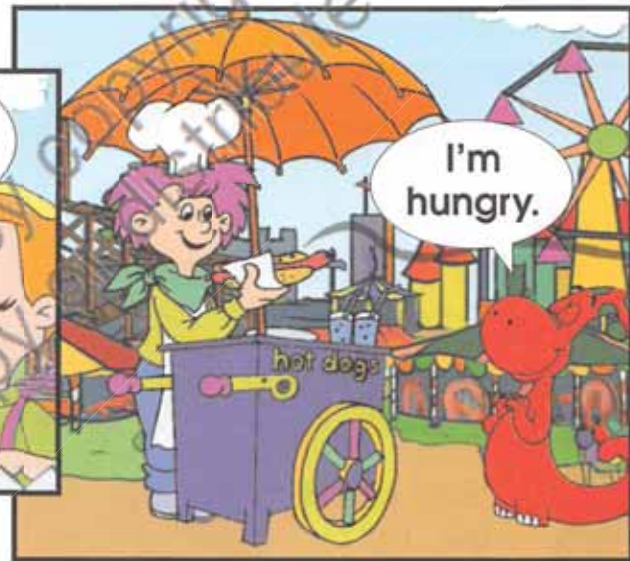
Now Jenny is wet.
