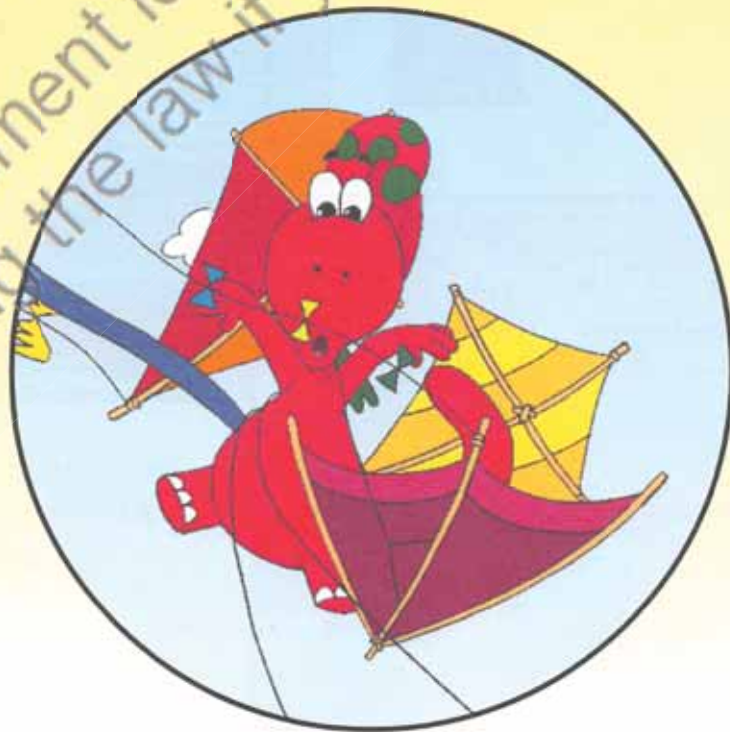

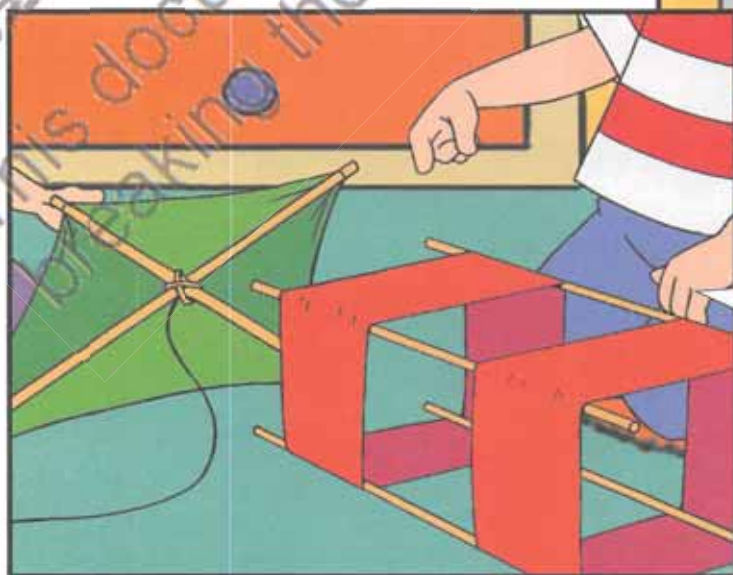
The yellow kite is hers.

Let's fly our kites.

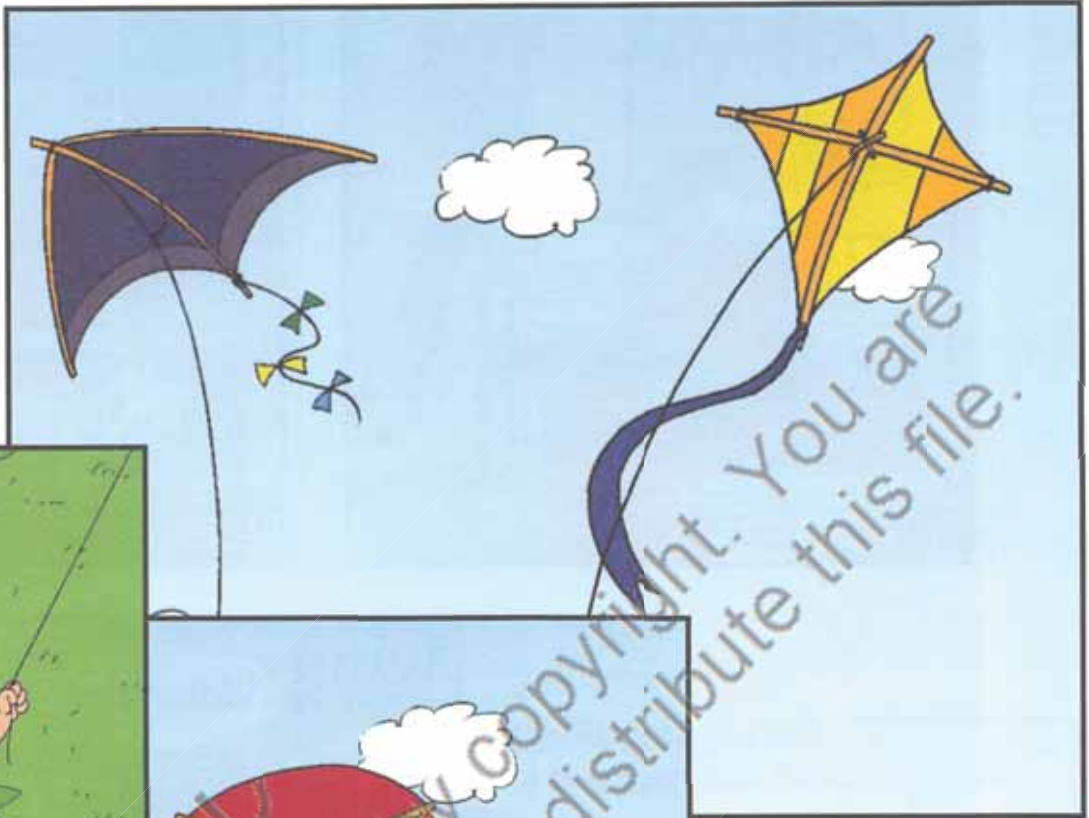
Yes. We can go to the park.

But Gogo can't move. He is stuck in the glue.

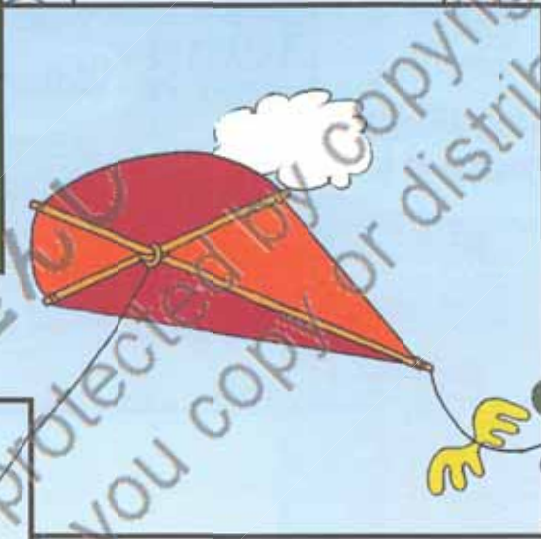


Oh, Gogo!

Gogo tries to untangle the kites but the wind blows him away.

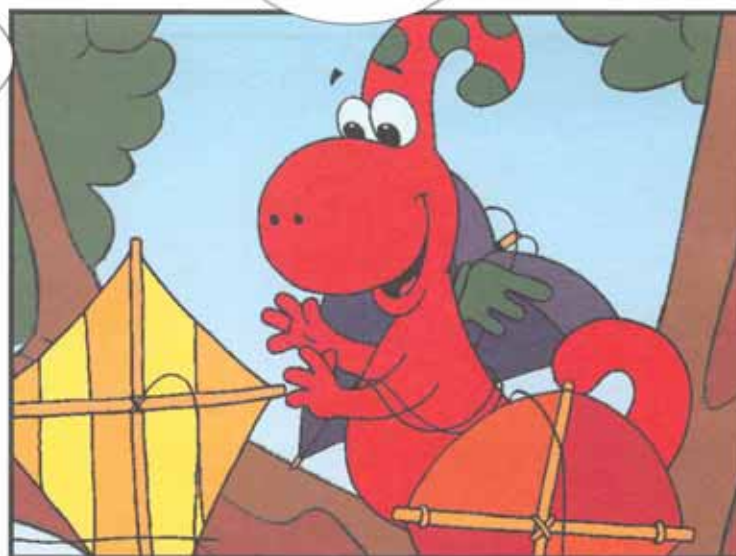
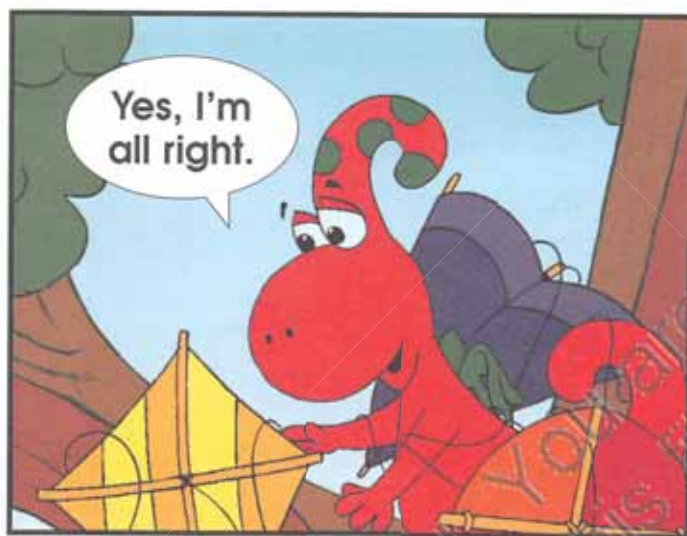
Whose kite is that?

The kites fly high.

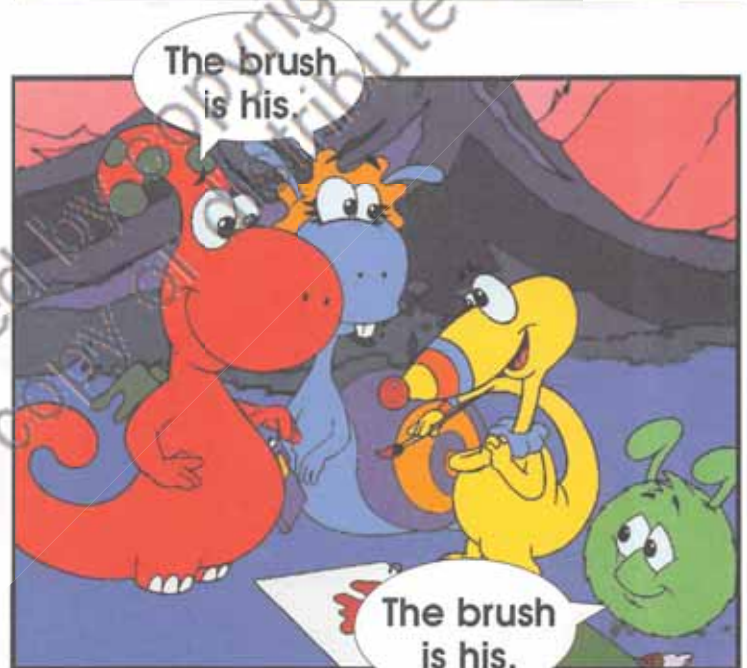
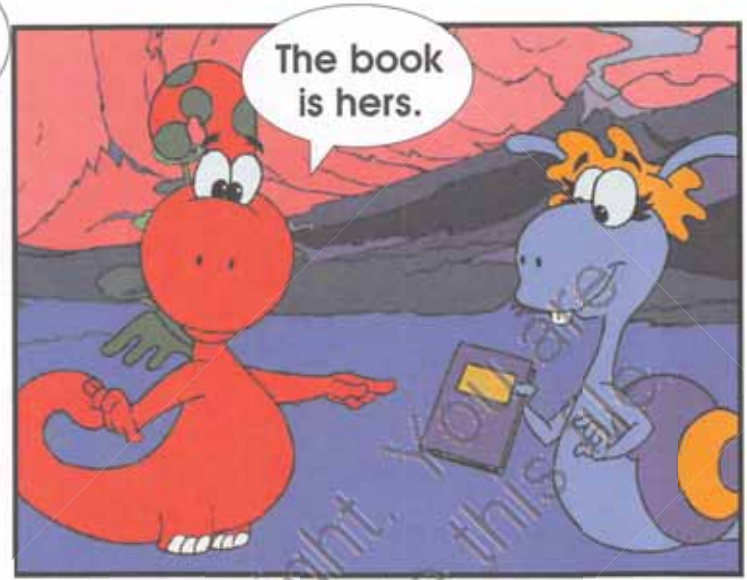




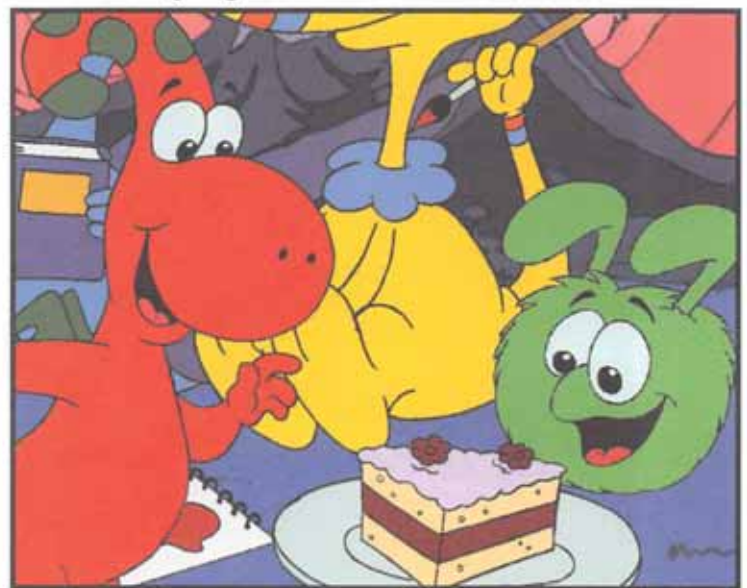

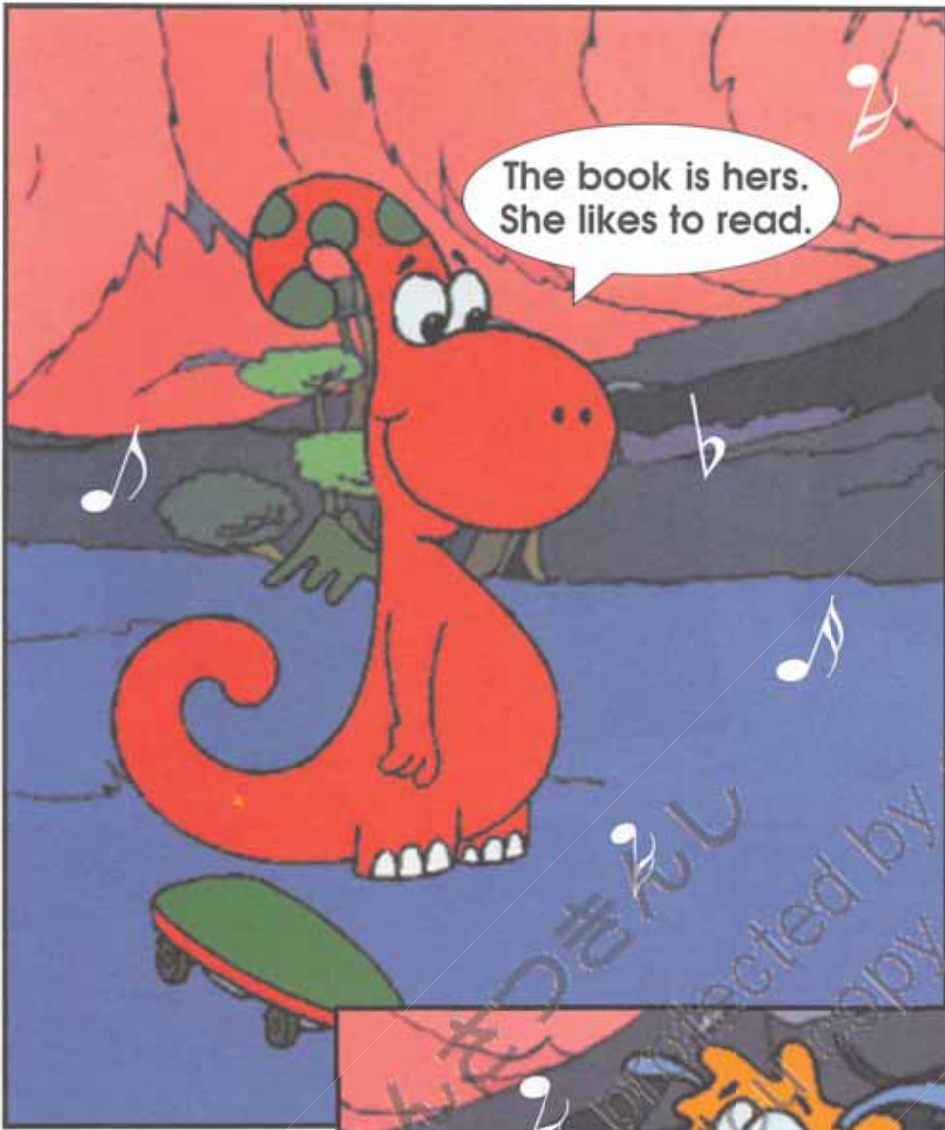


Gogo picks up the things.
