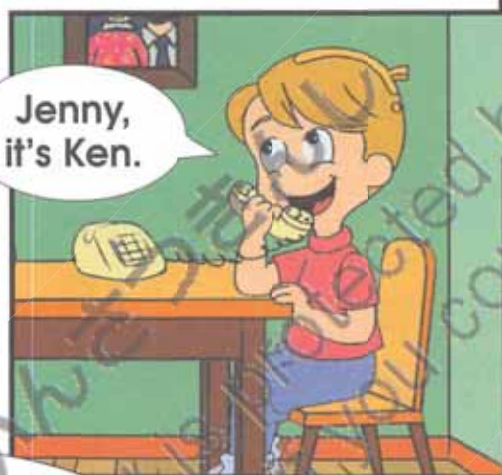

First, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth ...

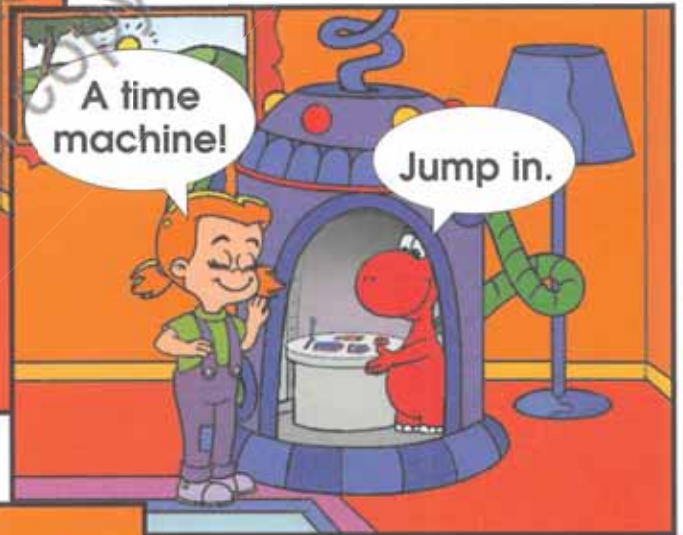
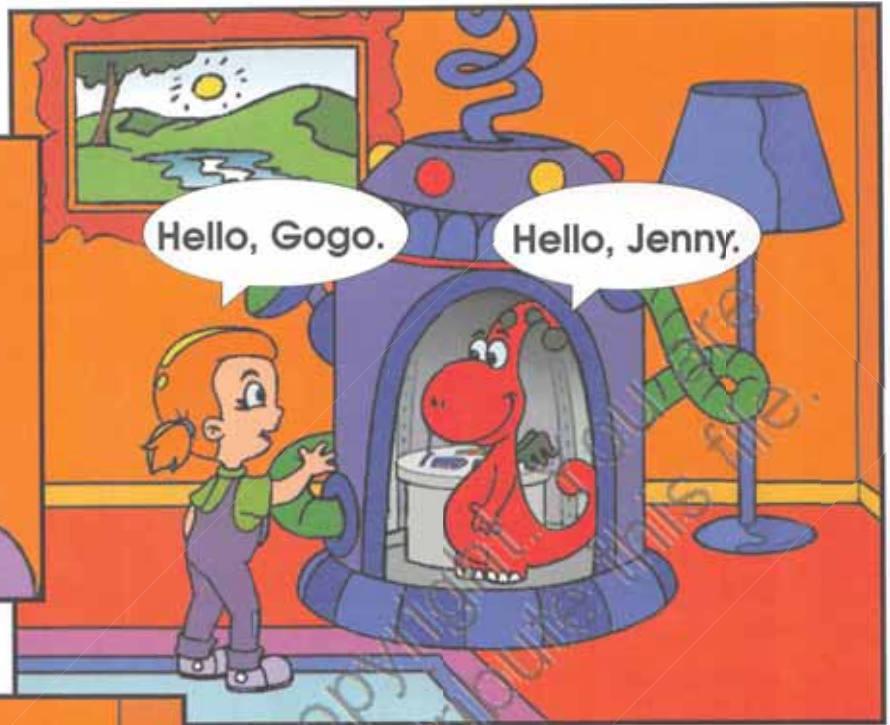


tenth! Good. I can go.



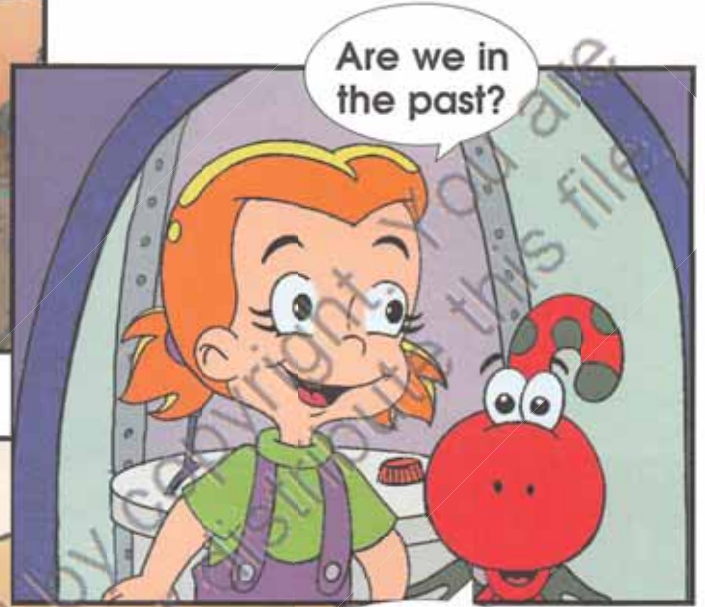
Yes, Ken. I can go to your party. See you July the tenth.

Gosh! Are we in the future?

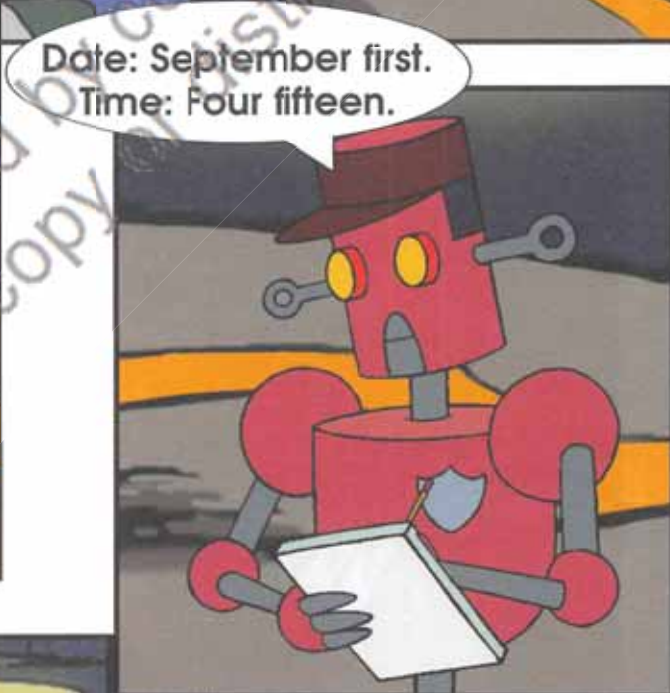
Yes, we are.

A policeman comes along.

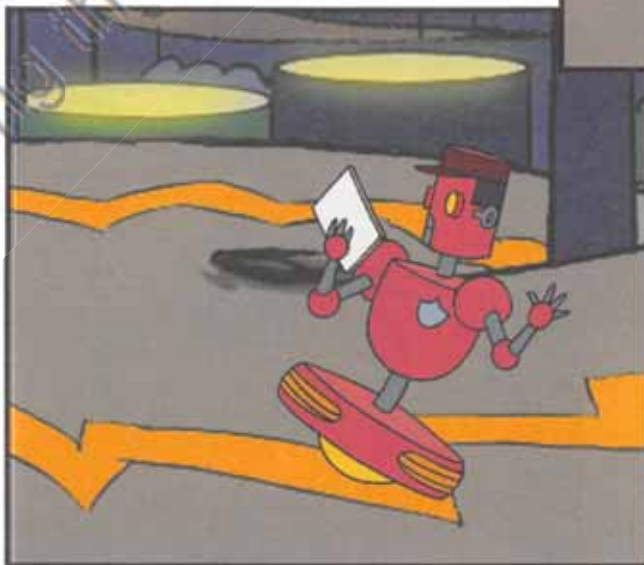


You can't park here.

Time: Four fifteen.



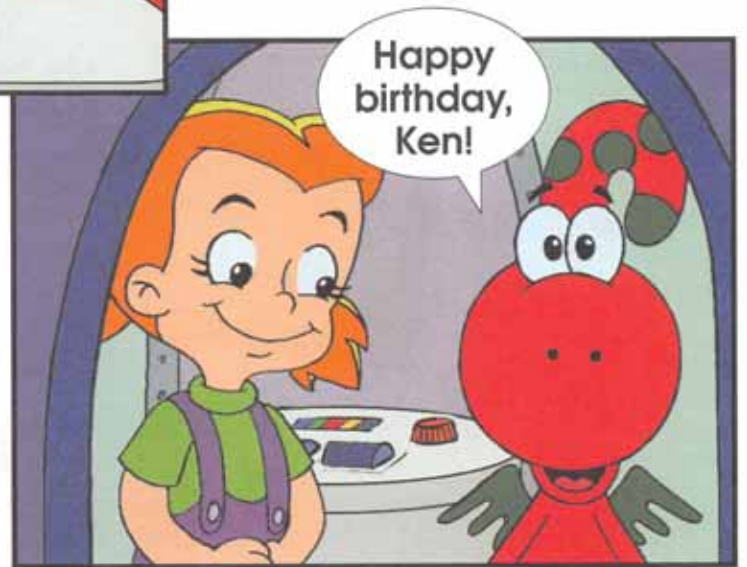
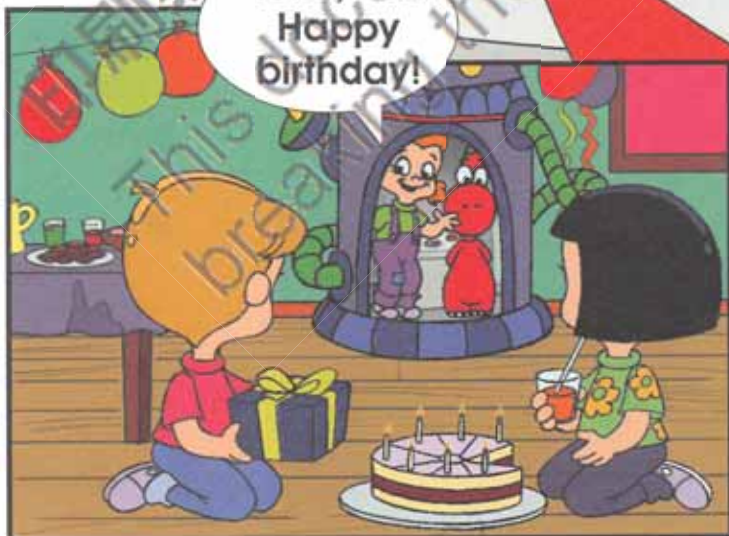
The policeman writes a ticket. But Gogo doesn't wait. He disappears.



Gogo changes the controls.

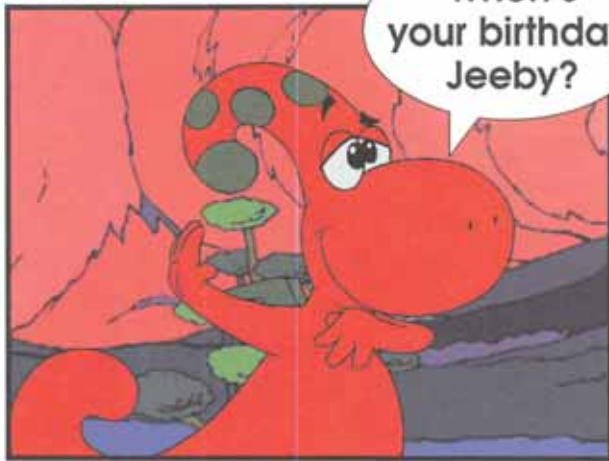


January, February, March, April, May, June, July!

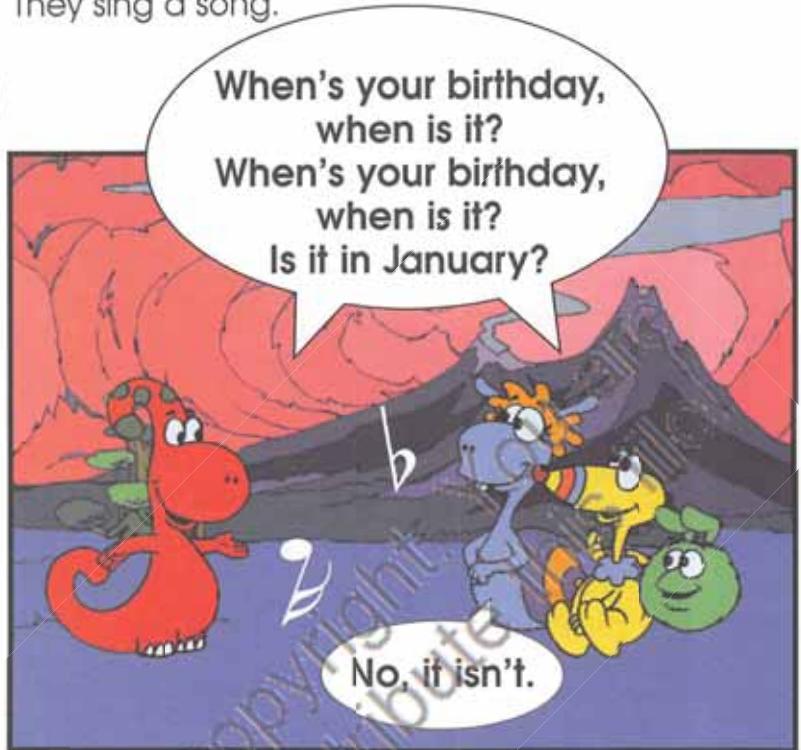


They go to Ken's party in the future.

Is it in March?

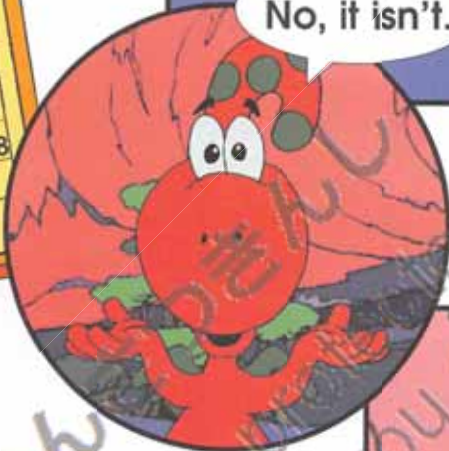


Yes, it is. My birthday's on March the tenth.





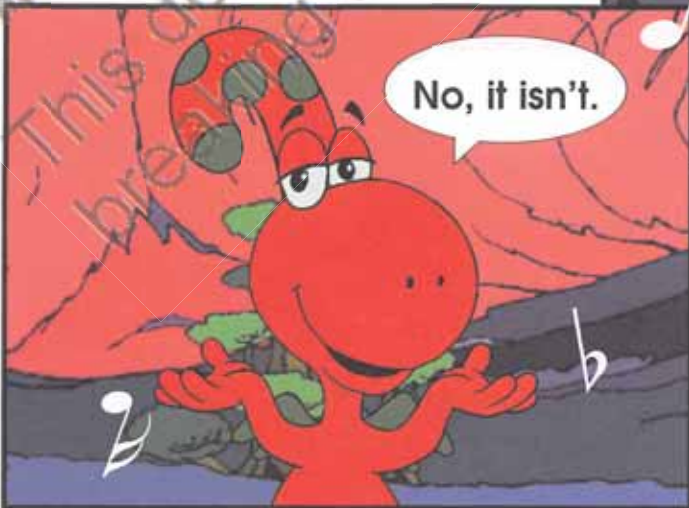
