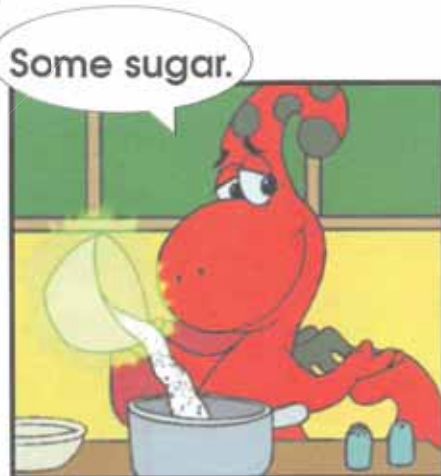
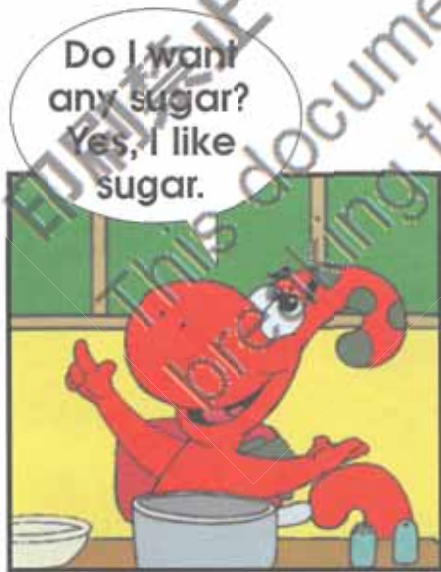
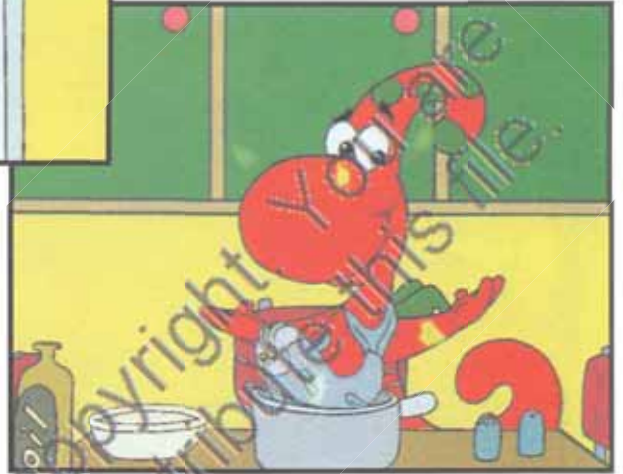




Jenny puts the meat in the saucepan.

Jenny makes a face.



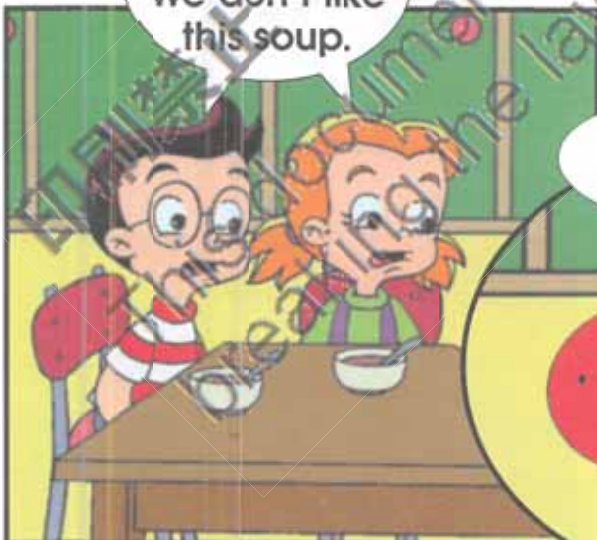
Gogo, what's in this soup?

I do.

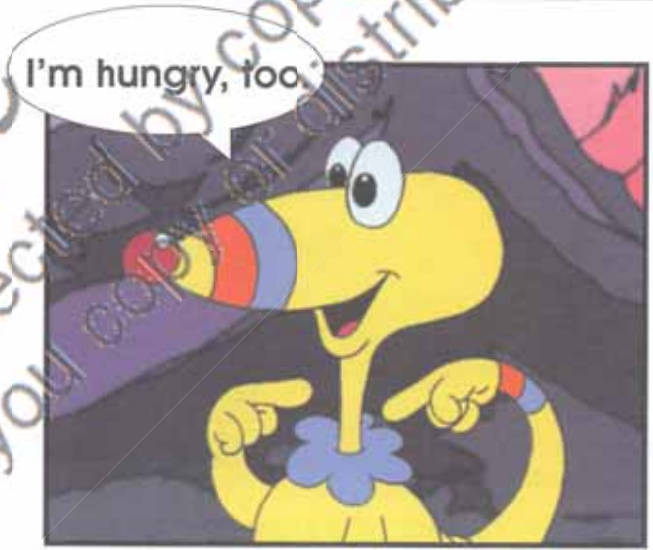
