One, two, three, four, five, six ...

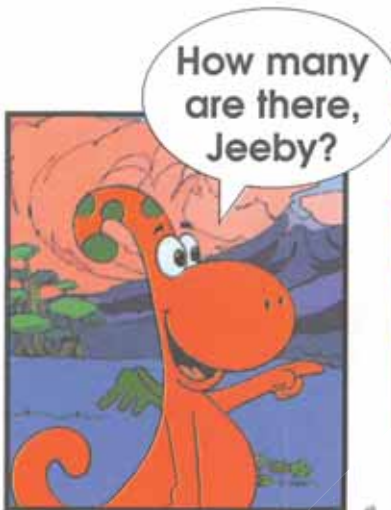
... seven, eight, nine, ten. There are ten steps, Gogo.

Tappy drops the eggs.

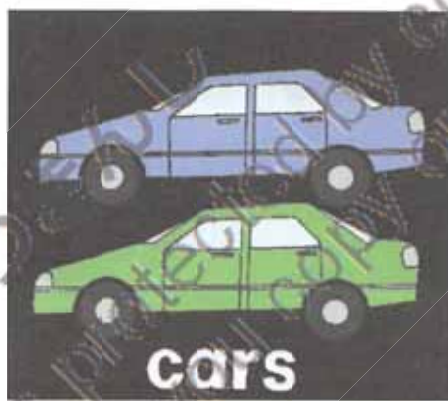
