## In/at/on (Place) (2)

We say:

in a line / in a row

in a photograph / in a picture / (look at yourself) in a mirror

in a book / in a newspaper / in a magazine / in a letter (but on a page)

When I go to the movies, I prefer to sit in the front row.

Who is the woman in that photograph? (not on that photograph)

Have you seen this article in the paper? (= newspaper)

We say in the front / in the back of a car, room, theater, group of people, etc.:


I was in the back of the car when the accident happened.

Let's sit in the front (of the theater).

John was standing in the back of the crowd.

We say:

on the left / on the right on the first floor / on the second floor, etc. on a map / on a menu / on a list on a farm / on a ranch on a street / on a river / on the coast on the way (to . . .)



Washington, D.C., is on the east coast of the United States on the Potomac River.

In Britain they drive on the left.

Our apartment is on the second floor of the building.

Here's a shopping list. Don't buy anything that's not on the list.

Have you ever worked on a farm? It's a lot like working on a ranch.

I live on Main Street. My brother lives on Elm.

We stopped at a small town on the way to Montreal.

We say on the front / on the back of a piece of paper, envelope, photograph, etc.:


Write your name on the back of this piece of paper.

at the top / at the bottom (of a page, a list, etc.) at the end (of a street, a road, etc.)

- Write your name at the top of the page.
- Angela's house is at the end of the street.

at the bottom (of the page)



We say "in the corner of a room," but "at the corner (or on the corner) of a street":

- The television is in the corner of the room.
- There is a public telephone at/on the corner of Charleston Street.
