# Adjective + Preposition (1)

It was nice of you to . . .

nice/kind/good/generous/polite/silly/stupid OF somebody (to do something):

- Thank you. It was very nice/kind of you to help me.
- It is stupid of her to go out without a coat in such cold weather.

but: (be) nice/kind/good/generous/polite/friendly/cruel TO somebody:

They have always been very nice/kind to me. (not with me)

### Adjective + about/with/at

mad/angry/furious/annoyed/upset ABOUT something:

Max is really angry about what his brother said.

mad AT somebody

angry/furious AT/WITH somebody | FOR doing something annoyed/upset WITH somebody

- Are you mad at me for being late?
- Pat's pretty upset with me for forgetting her birthday.

excited/worried/nervous/happy ABOUT something:

Carol is worried about not having enough money.

pleased/satisfied/disappointed WITH something:

Were you disappointed with your paycheck?



Max is really angry about what his brother said.

#### Adjective + at/by/with

surprised/shocked/amazed/astonished AT/BY something:

- Everybody was surprised at (or by) the news.
- I hope you weren't shocked by (or at) what I said.

impressed WITH/BY somebody/something:

I'm very impressed with (or by) her English. It's very good.

fed up / bored WITH something:

I don't like my job anymore. I'm fed up with it. / I'm bored with it.

### sorry about/for

sorry ABOUT something:

I'm sorry about the noise last night. We were having a party.

but: sorry FOR doing something:

I'm sorry for shouting at you yesterday.

You can also say "I'm sorry I (did something)":

I'm sorry I shouted at you yesterday.

We say "feel/be sorry FOR somebody":

I feel sorry for George. He has a lot of problems.

I'm sorry about the noise last night.
