Names With and Without the (1)

We do not use the with names of people (Ann, Ann Taylor, etc.). In the same way, we do not normally use the with names of places. For example:

continents countries and states Africa (not the Africa), Asia, South America France (not the France), Japan, Brazil, Texas

islands cities, towns, etc.

mountains

Bermuda, Sicily, Vancouver Island Cairo, New York, Bangkok Everest, Kilimanjaro, Fuji



But we use the in names with Republic, Kingdom, States, etc.:

the Dominican Republic

the United Kingdom (the UK)

the Czech Republic

the United States of America (the USA)

Compare:

We visited Canada and the United States.

When we use Mr./Mrs./Captain/Doctor, etc. + a name, we do not use the. We say: Mr. Johnson / Doctor Johnson / Captain Johnson / President Johnson, etc. (not the . . .) Uncle Robert / Aunt Jane / Saint Catherine / Princess Anne, etc. (not the . . .)

Compare:

We called the doctor but We called Doctor Johnson. (not the Doctor Johnson)

We use mount (= mountain) and lake in the same way (without the):

Mount Everest (not the . . .) Mount McKinley Lake Superior Lake Titicaca

They live near the lake. but They live near Lake Superior. (without the)
