all most some any much/many little/few

A You can use the words in the box (and also no) with a noun (some food / few books, etc.):

- All cars have wheels.
- I don't go out very often. I stay home most days.
- Some cars can go faster than others.
- Many people drive too fast.
- (on a sign) NO CARS (= no cars allowed)

You cannot say "all of cars," "most of people," etc. (see also Section B):

Some people are very unfriendly. (not some of people)

Note that we say most (not the most):

Most tourists don't visit this part of town. (not the most tourists)

B Some of ... / most of ... / none of ..., etc.

You can use the words in the box (also none and half) with of. We use some of / most of / none of, etc., + the/this/that/these/those/my, etc. For example:

- Some of the people I work with are very friendly.
- None of this money is mine.
- Have you read any of these books?
- I was sick yesterday. I spent most of the day in bed.

You don't need of after all or half. So you can say:

- All my friends live in Los Angeles. or All of my friends . . .
- Half this money is mine.

or Half of this money . . .

- "How many of these people do you know?" "None of them." / "A few of them."
- Do any of you want to come to a party tonight?
- Do you like this music?" "Some of it. Not all of it."

Before it/us/you/them you need of after all and half (all of, half of):

all of us (not all us) half of them (not half them)

You can use the words in the box (and also none) alone, without a noun:

- Some cars have four doors, and some have two.
- A few of the shops were open, but most (of them) were closed.
- Half (of) this money is mine, and half (of it) is yours. (not the half)
