





## HOW THE GRAMMAR WORKS:

### 4 kinds of questions:

Wh-Questions (be) What is your name?

Wh-Questions (regular verbs) Where do you live?

Yes/No Questions (be) Are you a typical student?

Yes/No Questions (regular verbs) Do you like your job?


