

CD Track 28: Story read with sound effects. Turn page after \$\mathbb{L}\$ sound.





This is Anna. She always asks questions. "What's your job?" asks Anna.




"I'm a veterinarian," says the woman.

"I'm not sure," says the woman. "I'm not a mechanic. I'm a factory worker. I make things in a factory."






"You're not wearing a uniform. What's your job?" asks Anna.






