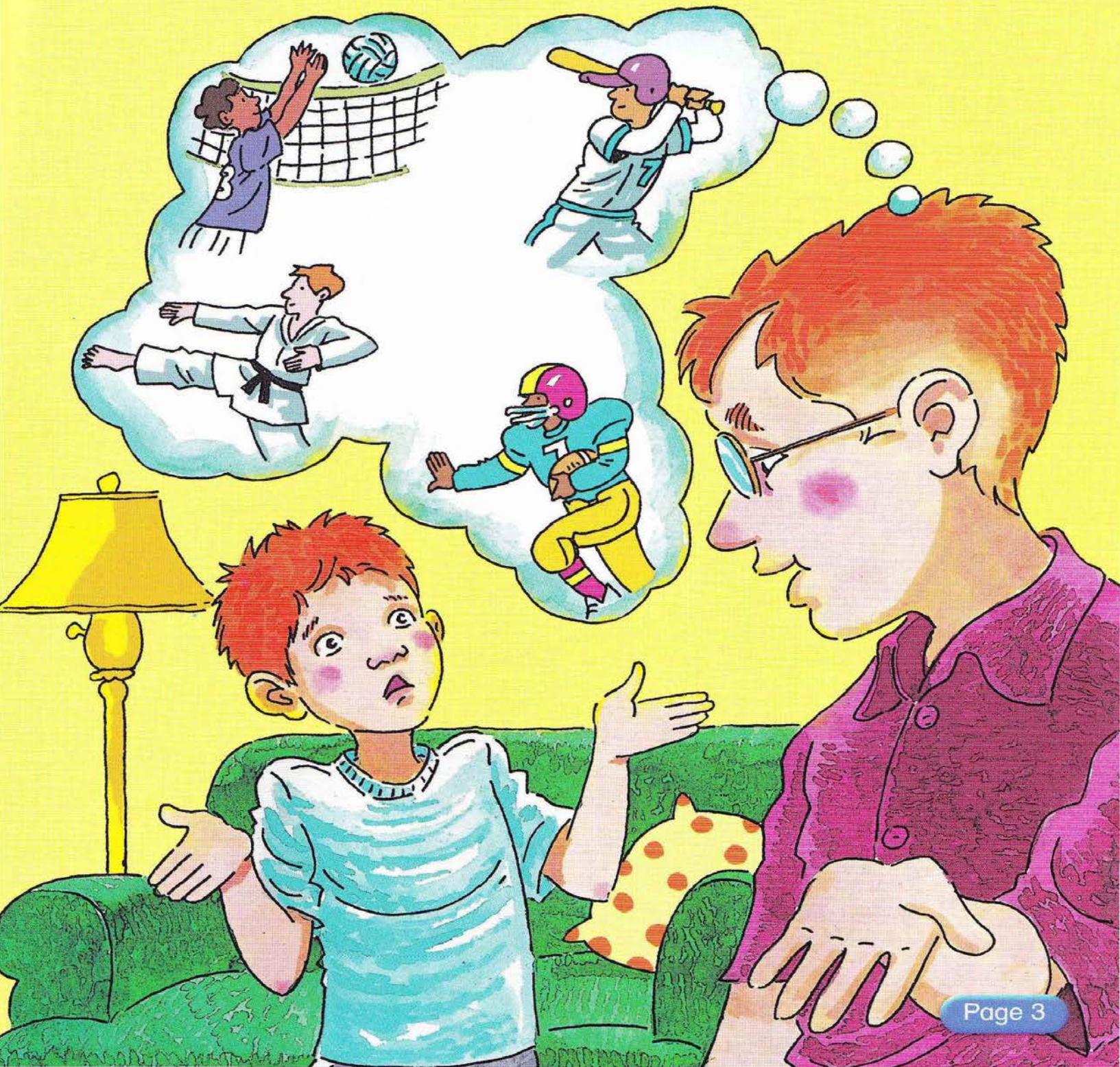

"I don't know," says Tom.



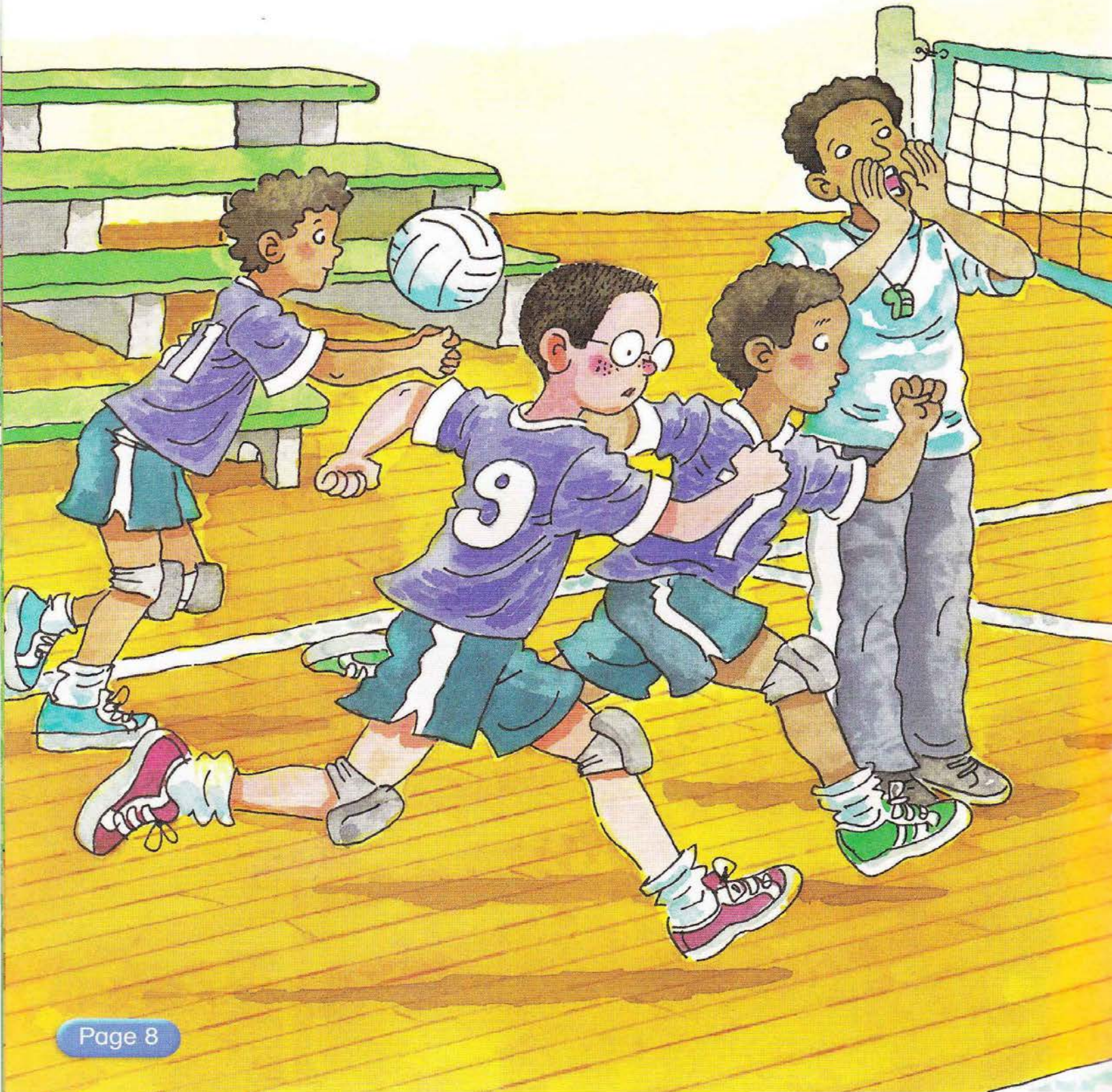
The football players are big. Tom is smaller than the football players. But he's faster.

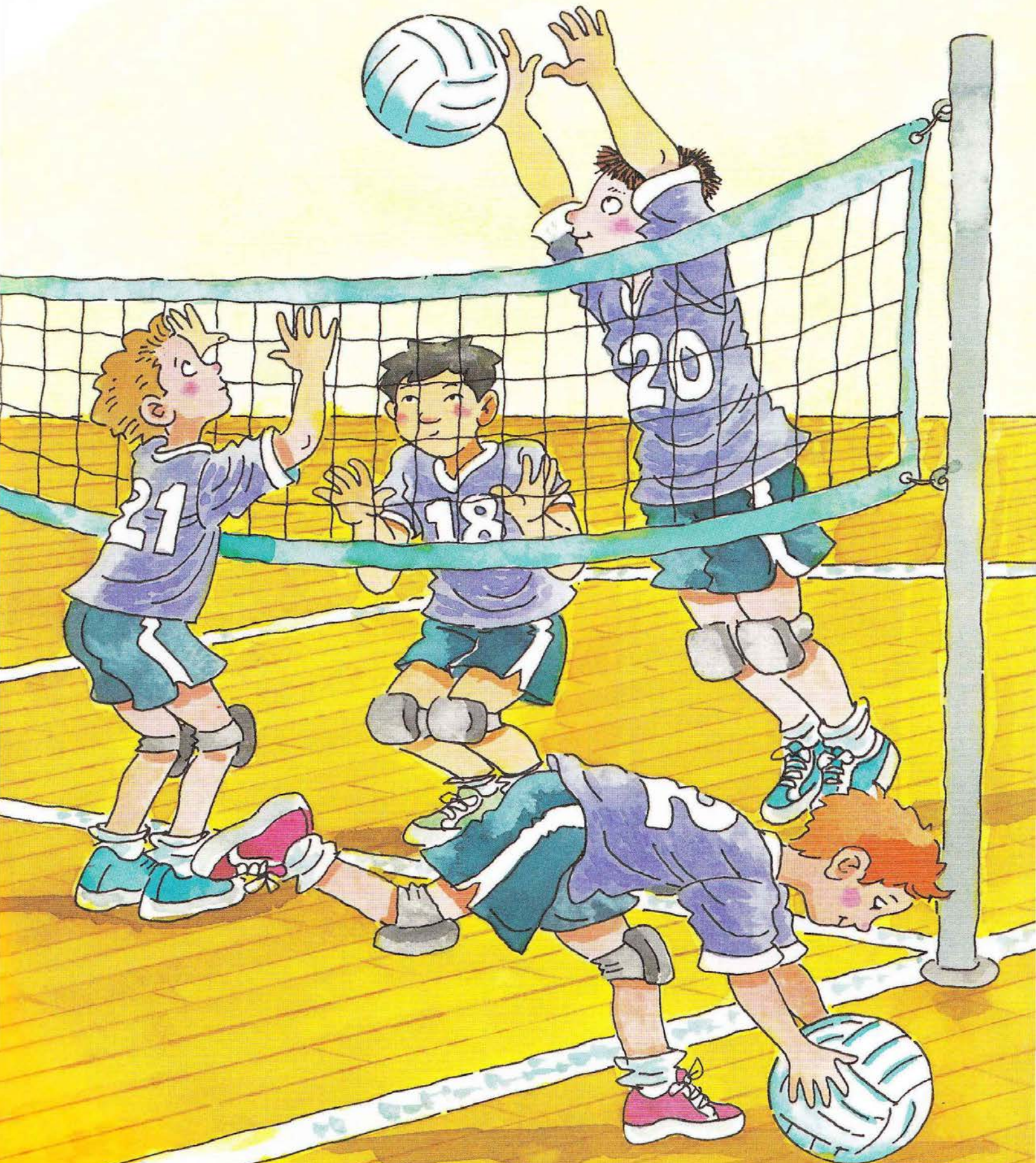






The volleyball players are tall. Tom is shorter than the volleyball players. But he's faster.







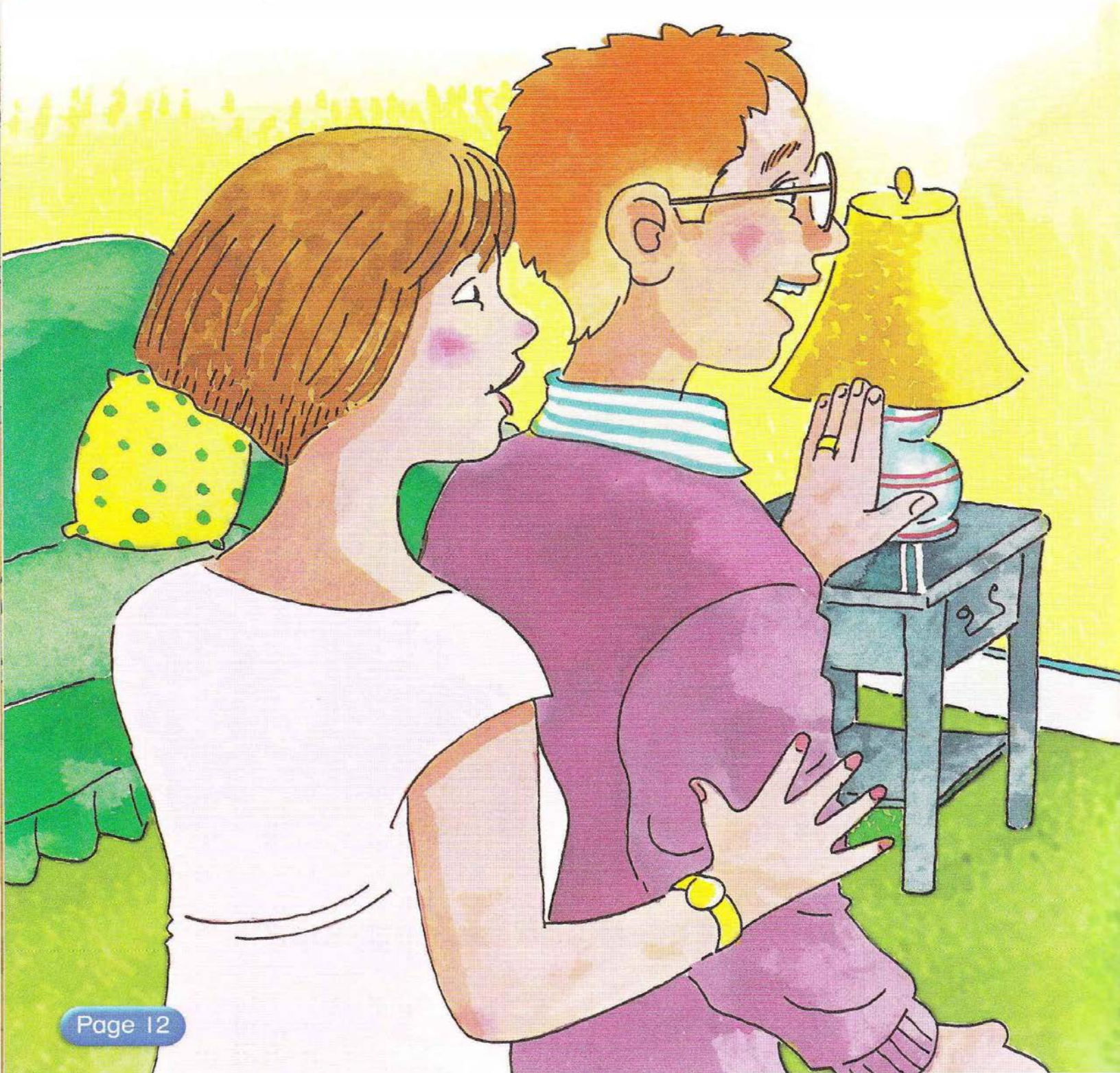
The runners are slower than Tom.

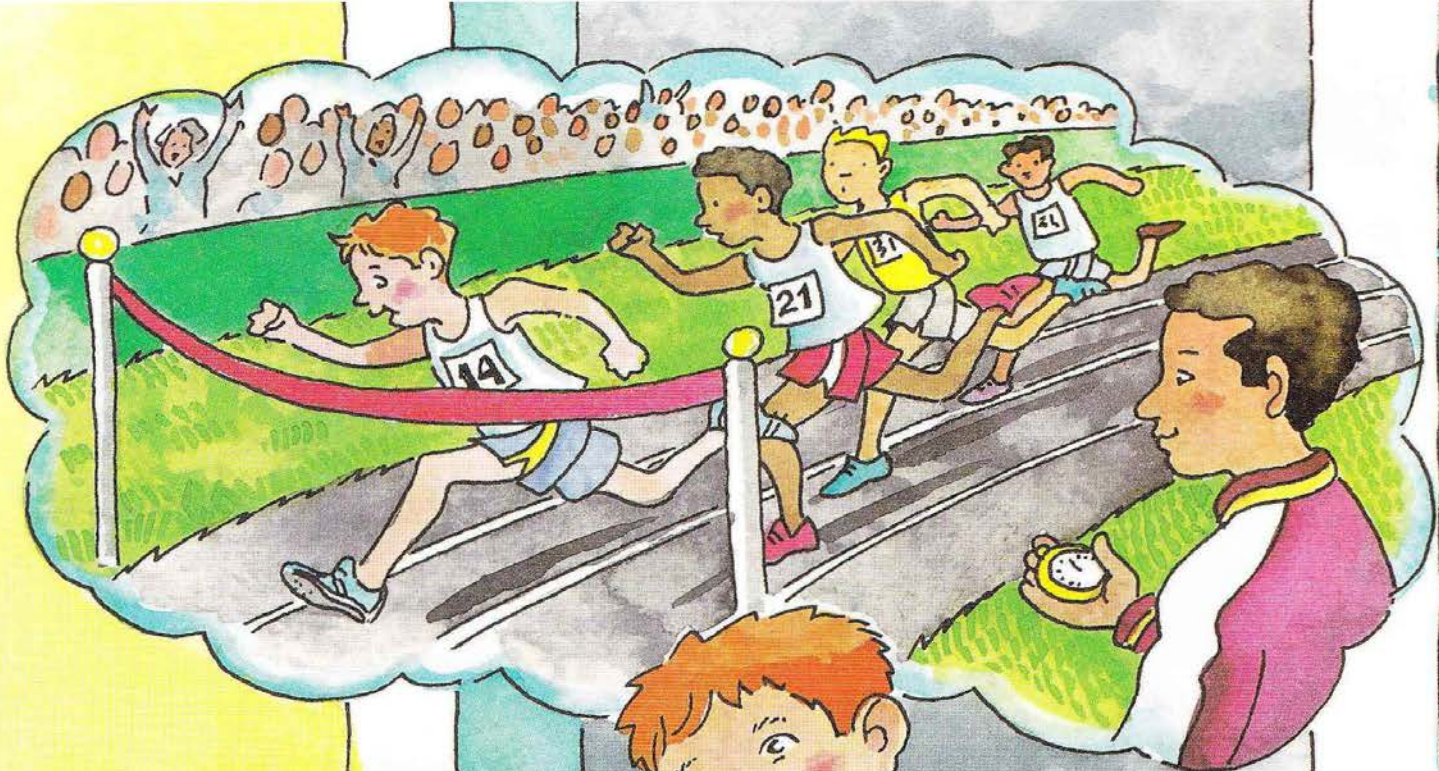


Tom is faster than his dog, too!

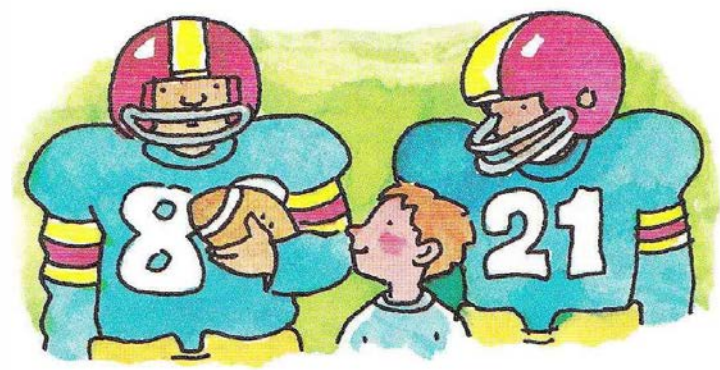
