

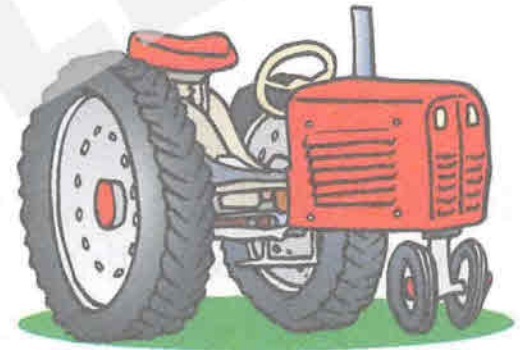
Lesson 3 Your Five Senses

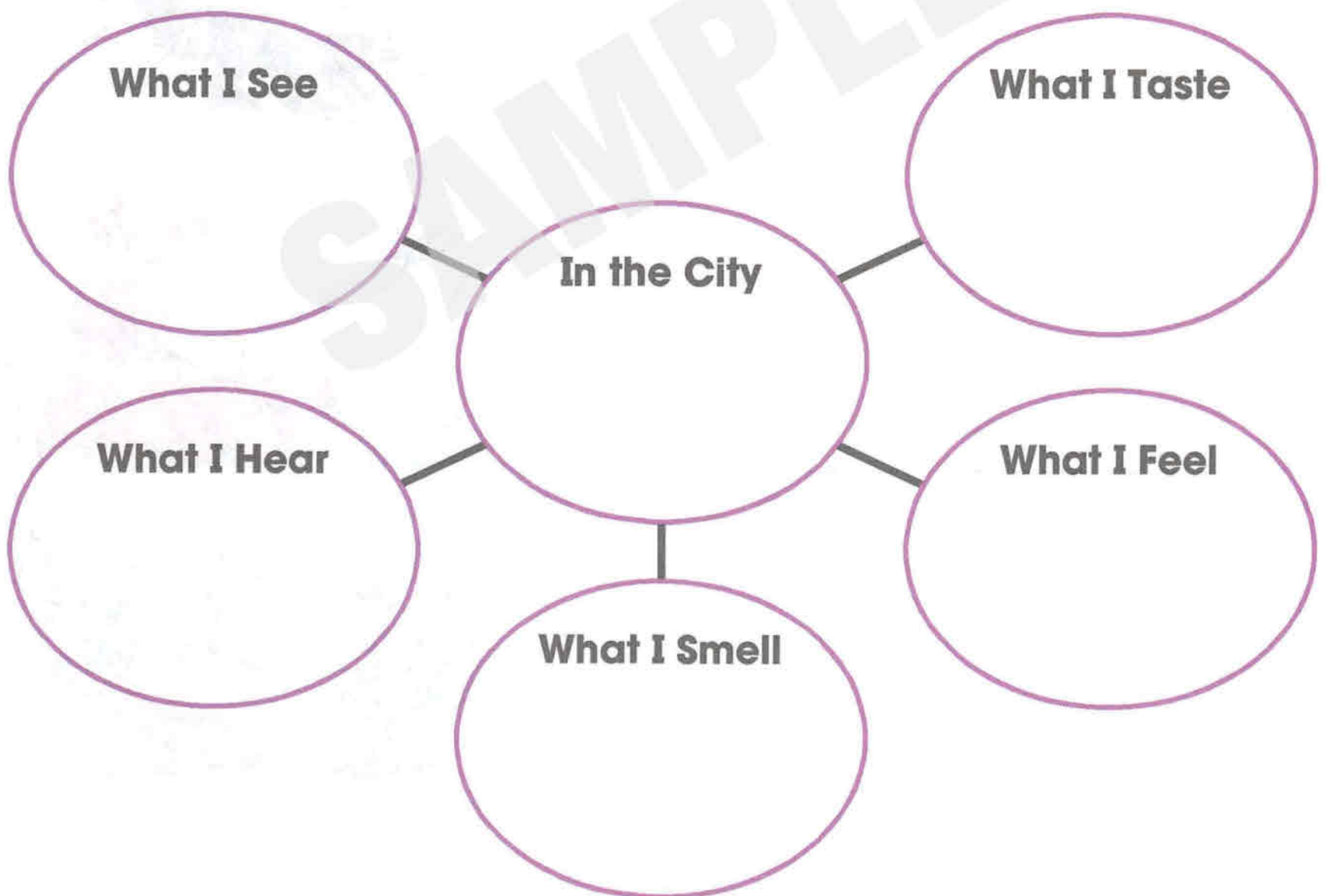
