Playing games with your family is fun.

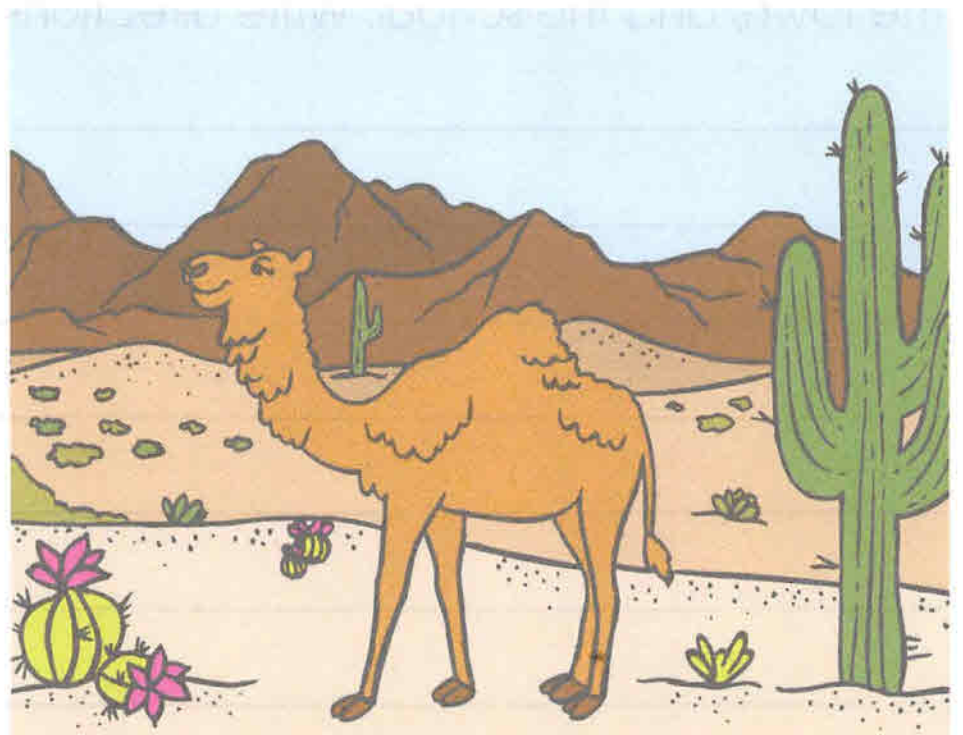
One picture can tell many things. If you look at the whole picture, though, it has one big, or main, idea. The sentence under the picture tells the main idea of the picture.

Nothing is alive in the desert.



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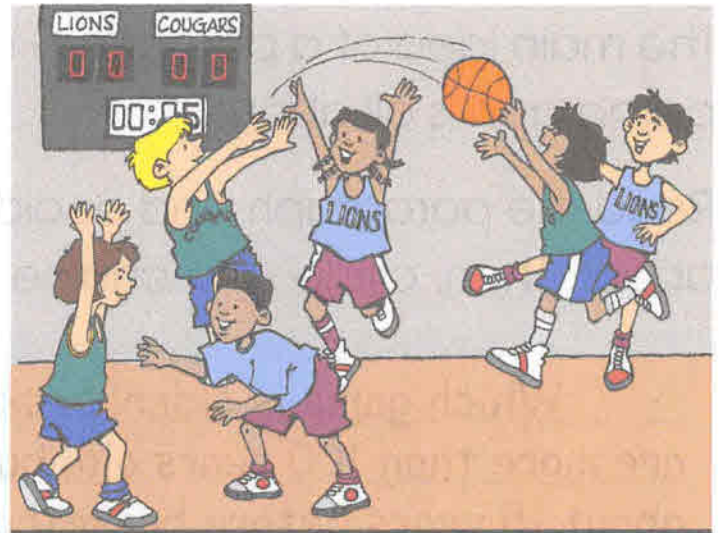
