

## Lesson 8 Compare It With a Venn

To compare two items, a Venn diagram is a useful tool. Kevin can't decide whether to play soccer or football. He made a Venn diagram to compare the two sports. He wrote things that are the same about the two sports in the center. Things that are different about soccer are in the left circle, and things that are different about football are in the right circle.




Now, compare bananas and lemons. Write what is different about bananas in the left circle. Write what is different about lemons in the right circle. Write what is the same about both fruits in the center.
