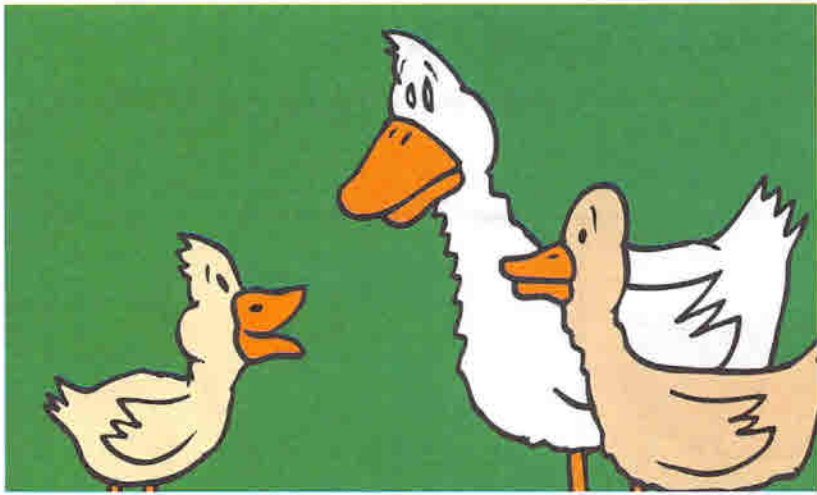
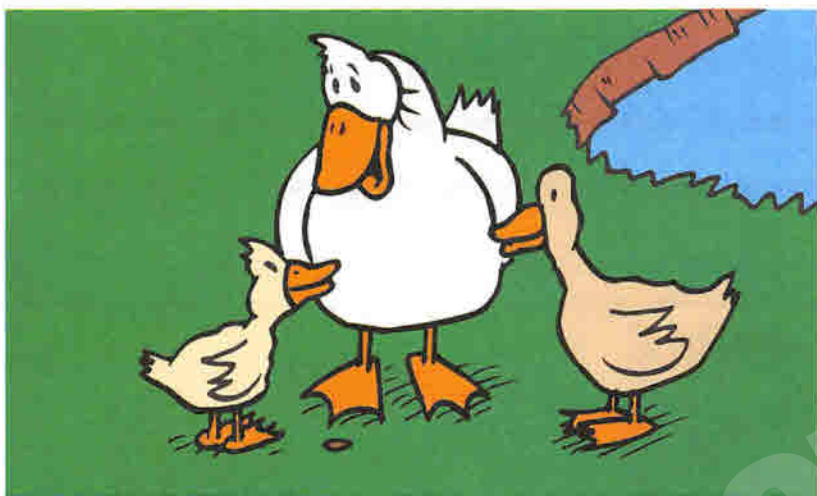


Make a Wish, Little Duck



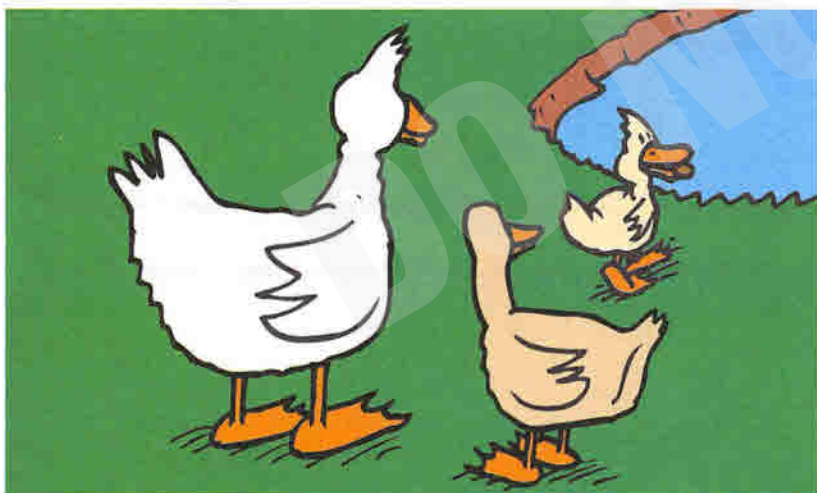
"What should I wish for?" asks Little Duck. "I already have everything I want. I have the best Mama Duck, and I have a best friend."

What would you wish for?



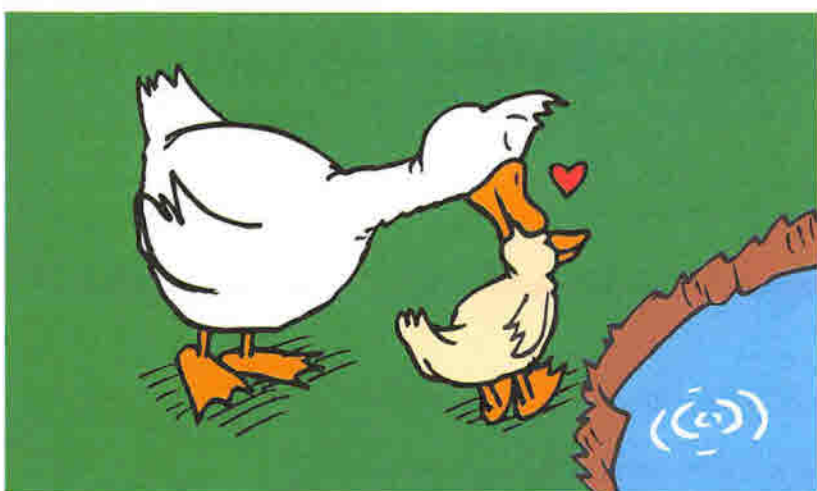
"Well, isn't there anything else you want, Little Duck?" asks Mama Duck.

What other animals can fly?

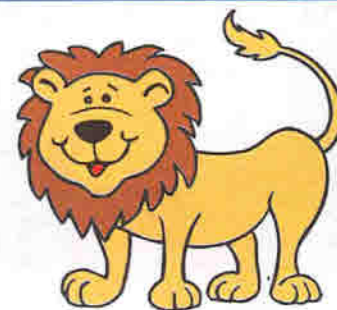

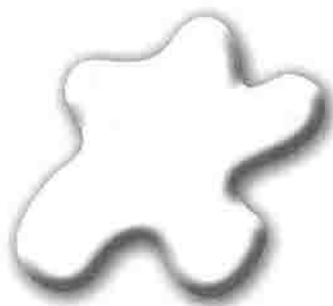
