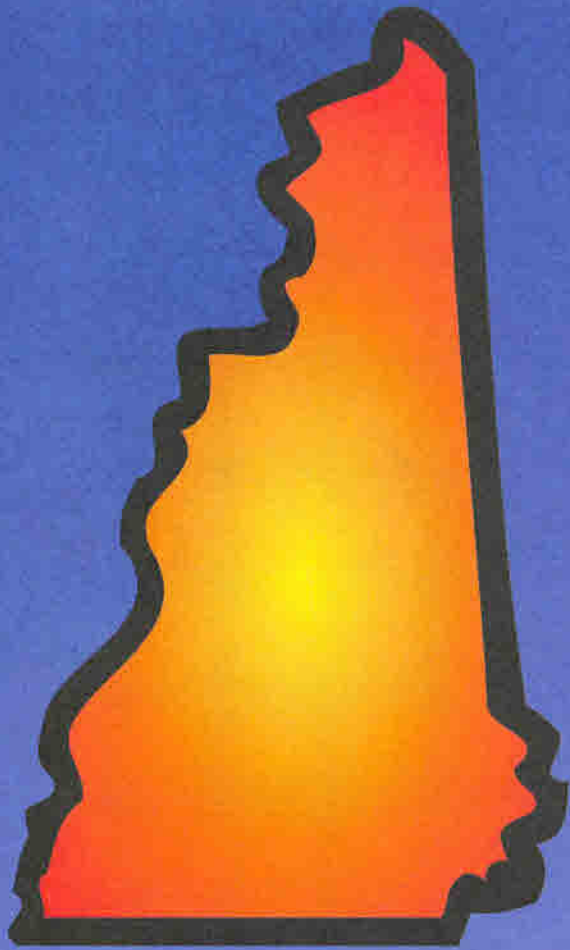
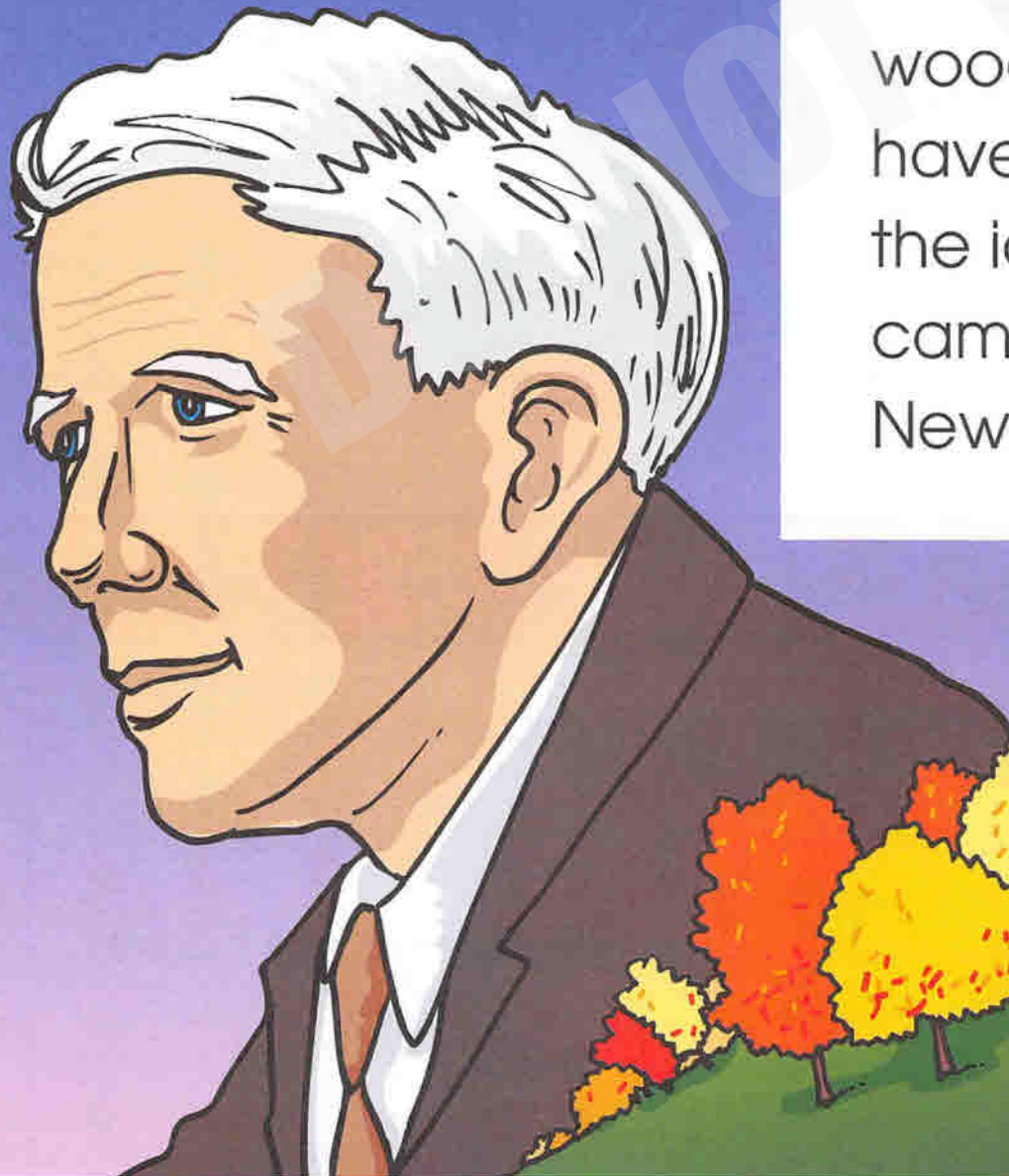


New Hampshire
