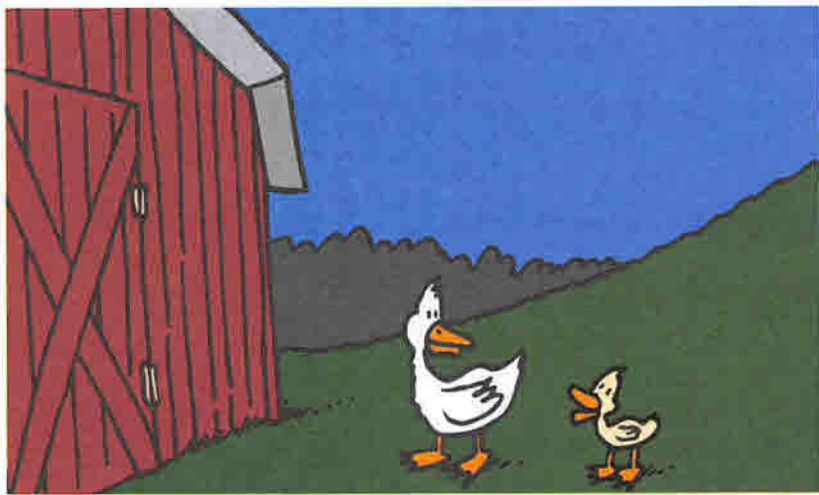
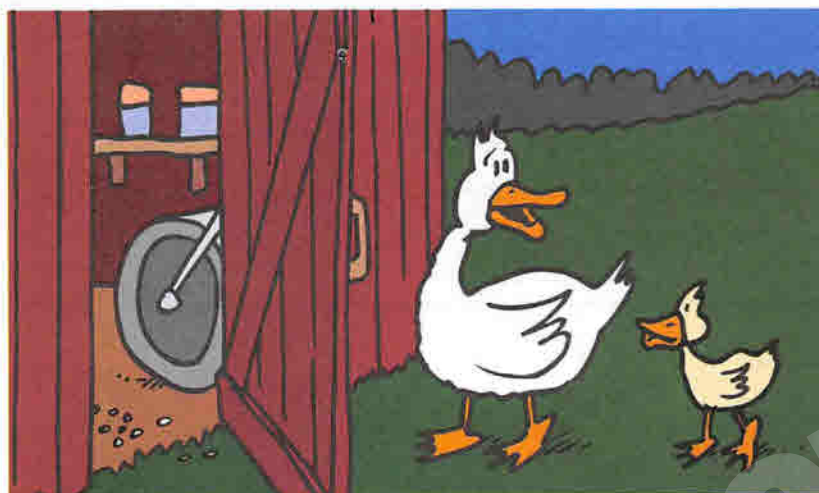


Bread Crumbs



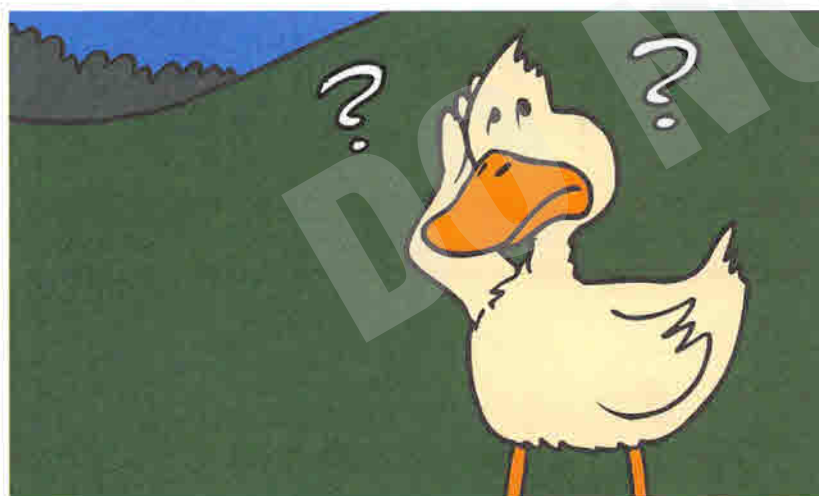
“What is a feast?” asks Little Duck.

Can feasts be different for different people?



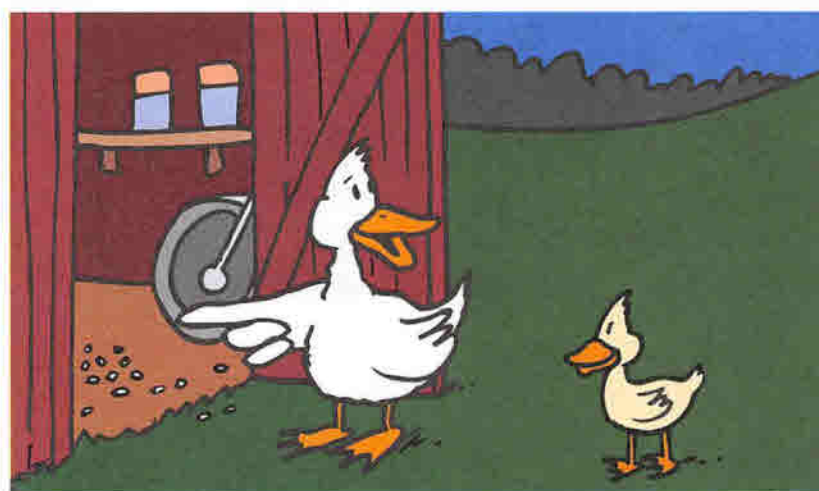
“A feast is a large dinner. Tonight, we are eating something special,” says Mama Duck.

Would you like to eat bread crumbs? Why or why not?

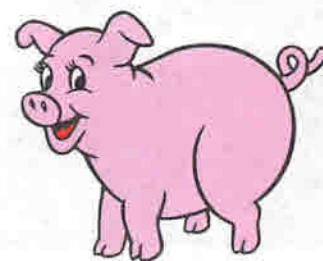
