## Key points (TIPS) for preparation:

- Use the 45 seconds preparation time to read through the test and read it out loud to yourself.
- Remember to concentrate on:
  - 1. Rhythm and stress at sentence level.
  - 2. Correct intonation in appropriate times.
  - 3. Correct use of syllables.
  - 4. Accurate pronunciation of sounds and sound combinations.

## **TEACHING FLOW**

- 1. Give the instructions to the student first.
- 2. Inform the student of the evaluation criteria.
  - ✓ Pronunciation
  - ✓ Intonation and stress
- 3. Time your student the first reading. If they exceed 45 seconds let them be.

- 4. Correct the mispronounced words. Make the student read it as a word and as a part of the sentence.
- 5. Guide the student's intonation and stressing.

Time this as well and compare with the 1<sup>st</sup> reading. The students goal is to be able to read it in 45 sec sharp with correct pronunciation, intonation and stressing.
- 7. Repeat as needed.
