NEW YORK CITY, USA ¹Who can eat the most hot dogs* in 12 minutes? Each year on the July 4 holiday, Nathan's Famous restaurant in New York City has a contest** to find out. The best eaters in the world come to the restaurant. ²Takeru "Tsunami" Kobayashi of Japan entered the contest in 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 and won all four times!

³Kobayashi, 26, is a **thin** man—as thin as a **pencil**. Many other eaters in the contest are much

bigger than Kobayashi. ⁴But never mind—Kobayashi can eat faster! At Nathan's, he pushes two hot dogs at once. ⁵He dances just a little when he eats. "It helps me," he explains. "I eat even fast when I dance." ⁶In 2004, his best year ever Kobayashi finished 53½ hot dogs in 12 minutes. "He's the best," say people at Nathan's. "No ever ate so many."






