still *adv* a word that shows that nothing changed

stranger *n* someone you do not know

friendly *adj* nice to people

conversation *n* when two or more people talk about something

everywhere *adv* in all places

park *n* an open place with trees and flowers; you can walk and play there

make *v* to cause something to happen

comfortable *adj* feeling happy and relaxed

silence *n* when there is silence, there is no noise

wall *n* something that keeps people apart; it is also a strong and hard thing between rooms or houses, or around a town
