She remained calm while her friends got her to the beach. Although she was bleeding heavily and in pain, she never cried.

<sup>4</sup>Bethany is one of the best young surfers in the USA. <sup>5</sup>Several weeks after she lost her arm, she was smiling on TV and telling her story. "I'm lucky," she said. "I'm alive!" <sup>6</sup>A month after the attack, Bethany returned to the water on her surfboard. <sup>7</sup>Friends on the beach cried when Bethany stood up on her board and rode her first wave. <sup>8</sup>"Man, she's fantastic," said a friend. "She gives people hope."


