
## The Smartest Home

When Gates enters a room, the lights turn on by themselves. He doesn't need to turn them off because they darken automatically as he leaves. <sup>5</sup>His favorite

music plays in each room as he walks through the house, and it can even follow him outside. 6When he jumps into the **pool** for a swim, the same music plays underwater. 7Gates has a lot of art on his walls, but he never gets tired of it. The pictures change automatically because they are digital\*\*\*.

<sup>8</sup>A "smart home" is expensive now, but we can all **look forward to** living in **one** in the future. "It's going to happen very quickly," **promises** Dave Farber of the University of Pennsylvania.






