BRIDGEWATER, MASS., USA ¹One winter day, Mike Hill was **hunting** for birds near a **lake**. The ground was wet, and his boots got stuck* in the **mud**. He could not get out. ²Hill quickly **became** cold and **scared**, and he phoned for help.

³First, three fire fighters came to **save** Hill but had no **success**. They tried to get to him by boat, but their **engine** got stuck in the mud. So they tried to walk to Hill, but their boots got stuck. Now no one **was able to** move! ⁴Then a policeman

and a dog came in a special car with large wheels. It got stuck, too.

⁵Finally, a **helicopter** arrived to save the day. It pulled everyone up from the mud **safely**. **One by one**, Hill, the fire fighters, the policeman, and the dog went up through the trees in a muddy **basket**. ⁶"It was a pretty big **mess**," said the helicopter **pilot**.
