# 16 Time words (I): days, months and seasons

### A Basic time words

There are:

365 days in a year

12 months in a year

52 weeks in a year

7 days in a week

2 weeks in a fortnight

24 hours in a day

60 minutes in an hour. (We say an hour hour)

60 seconds in a minute

100 years in a century

## Days of the week

Sunday , Monday , Monday , Tuesday, Wednesday , Thursday, Friday, Saturday.

The names of the days always begin with a capital letter in English.

Saturday + Sunday = the weekend



Monday (before 12 a.m.) = Monday morning

Monday (between 12 a.m. and 6 p.m.) = Monday afternoon

Monday (after 6 p.m.) = Monday evening

We say on + days of the week: on Monday, on Saturday, etc. I saw her on Friday, on Tuesday evening.

We say at + the weekend: I went to the cinema at the weekend.

### Months and seasons

Months: January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.

The names of the months always begin with a capital letter in English.

Some countries have four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and and winter



We say in + months/seasons: in July, in December, in (the) spring, in (the) summer, etc. My birthday is in July. [NOT on July] Birds sing in (the) spring.
