## TOEIC Speaking Questions 4-6 Respond to Questions

## Question 4-6 Lesson flow:

**Introduction:** (Be read to the students as an introduction of what the test is all about)

- 1. In Questions 4-6, you will be asked to imagine that you are taking part in a market research interview.
- 2. You will be asked to respond to three related questions without preparation.
- 3. The questions will be about familiar topics: entertainment, purchases, dining, friends, news, movies, travel, etc.
- 4. Your answer is assessed according to the good use of relevant vocabulary and structure and the appropriate answer to the question.
- 5. You will have 15 seconds to answer question 4, another 15 seconds for question 5, and 30 seconds for question 6.

## **Test tips**

- Know how to answer opinion questions- Many of the questions in this part
  of the test will ask you about your favorite thing, or about things you prefer
  or like. Do not just give one word answer say why.
- 2. Watch out for questions with two parts. Answer both. For instance, Where would you like to travel ,and why?
- 3. Know how to communicate basic information. To start your answer, you rephrase the question by picking out the keywords. This will give you extra time to think about what you want to say and avoid long pauses. In cases, where you need think time, use English hesitation devices.

4. Give as much information as you can. You can explain, give example or

evidence.

5. Know how to answer How questions. How questions have many functions.

They can ask about methods, ask about quantities, and time. So you need

to know what the question asks you about.

6. Become familiar with how you organize your answer. Here are examples for

organizing opinion and describe questions:

For Opinion questions

Question: What do you think is a good way to keep fit? Why?

1. Begin with an introduction sentence that gives your opinion and includes

words from the question.

-In my opinion, doing an exercise is a good way to keep fit.

2. Think of two or three reasons to support your opinion.

Some of the reasons are exercise allows you to move that can strengthen

your muscles, this can also help in the circulation of blood.

3. If you can think of opposing points, you may add them.

4. If you added an opposing point, add a final conclusion sentence.

For 'describe' question:

Question: Describe your favorite part of the house

1. Begin with an introduction sentence that says what you are describing

and includes words from the question.

Ans. I would have to say that my favorite part of the house is bedroom.

- 2. Give reason why you chose this thing/person/place
  Answer: The reason why I say this because I think the bedroom can give
  me a sense of privacy. It is also a place where I can relax.
- 3. Describe the thing, place, person. Use adjectives, words that talk about appearance, character to give much information.
