



I'm Edith. I'm going to my grandfather's. He lives in a house.







There is a big basement in my grandfather's house. My grandfather says, "Hi, Edith. Come here. I'm in the basement."






My grandfather says, "Look, Edith. These are my ice skates. They were in the entryway."







"Where are the ice skates now, Grandpa?" I ask. He says, "They're in that box on the shelf."






"Where are the books now, Grandpa?" I ask. He says, "They're in the bedroom. I read books at night."






"Where is the bookshelf now?" I ask.
