

**#16 Daily Chat** Clothes Shopping 衣料の買い物

**1.** Let's Practice a Short Dialogue: Practice these conversations with your students.先生と一緒にこれらの会話を練習しましょう。

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Conversation 1

**A: Do you like this shirt?**

**A:** このシャツ好き？

**B: Yes, I love the color.**

**B:** うん、色が大好き。

**C: No, it's too bright.**

**C:** ううん、明るすぎるよ。

Teacher Note: Use this dialogue to talk about colors and personal taste in clothes.

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Conversation 2

**A: Which one do you like?**

**A:** どれが好き？

**B: I like the blue one.**

**B:** 青いのが好き。

**C: This one catches my eye.**

**C:** これは目を引くね。

Teacher Note: Practice expressing choices and describing what stands out.

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Conversation 3

**A: Is this too big?**

**A:** これ大きすぎる？

**B: It does seem a little large.**

**B:** ちょっと大きいかもね。

**C: No, it fits me.**

**C:** ううん、ぴったりだよ。

Teacher Note: Use this dialogue to explore size and fit. Students can practice polite agreement and disagreement.

Conversation 4

**A: Can I try this on?**

**A:** これ試着していい？

**B: Sure, go ahead.**

**B:** もちろん、どうぞ。

**C: Yes, the room is there.**

**C:** うん、試着室あっちだよ。

Teacher Note: Practice asking for permission and giving directions in a store setting.

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Conversation 5

**A: Do these shoes fit?**

**A:** この靴ぴったり？

**B: Yes, they're perfect.**

**B:** うん、ぴったりだよ。

**C: No, they're too small.**

**C:** ううん、小さすぎる。

Teacher Note: Encourage students to talk about comfort and size when shopping.

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2. Activity: Role Play Practice

Example Dialogue: Conversation 3

**A: Is this too big?**

**B: It does seem a little large.**

**C: No, it fits me.**

Teacher Note: Encourage students to try the role play with their own clothes or pictures of clothes.

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3. Activity: Create Your Own Dialogue
