Lesson 8: Sales Strategy Brainstorming

Role-Play Dialogue Text (Approx. 10 minutes):

Sales Manager: Good morning, team. We need to brainstorm new strategies to boost our sales figures.

Team Member A: Good morning. I think we should focus on digital channels to reach more prospects.

Sales Manager: That's a good point. If we optimize our online campaigns, then we could see an increase in conversion rates.

Comprehension Questions and Sample Answers (Approx. 5 minutes):

1. **Q:** What is the goal of the brainstorming session?

A: The goal is to develop new strategies to boost sales figures.

2. **Q:** How does the team use conditionals to suggest improvements?

A: For example, "If we optimize our online campaigns, then we could see an increase in conversion rates."

3. **Q:** Which modal verbs are used?

A: "Should" and "could/might" (e.g., "we should focus on digital channels," "this approach might generate higher revenue").

4. **Q:** What is the final plan proposed?

A: To combine the ideas into a detailed sales strategy proposal.

Teacher's Lesson Points (Concise Version):

- **Prep:** Review vocabulary (sales, conversion rate, prospect, strategy, revenue) and conditionals.
 - **Intro (2–3 min):** Discuss recent sales trends briefly.
