Technology Upgrade and IT Strategy Meeting

1. Role-Play Dialogue Text (Approximately 10 minutes)

Characters:

- CIO (Chief Information Officer) Responsible for IT strategy and infrastructure.
- IT Manager Oversees daily IT operations and provides technical insights.

Setting:

Dialogue:

- 4. Why does the IT Manager mention cost estimation?

 Sample Answer: The IT Manager mentions cost estimation because the upgrades require budget approval, and a clear financial plan is necessary.

3. Teacher's Lesson Points (Concise Version)

Pre-Class Preparation:

 Review the dialogue and key vocabulary (IT infrastructure, upgrade, productivity, cybersecurity, encryption). • Be ready to explain modal verbs (e.g., could, might) and conditionals (ifthen structures).

Introduction (2-3 minutes):
