

#19 Daily Chat Playing in the park - 公園で遊ぶ

1. Let's Practice a Short Dialogue: Practice these conversations with your students.先生と一緒にこれらの会話を練習しましょう。

Conversation 1

A: Do you like swings?

A: ブランコは好き？

B: Yes, they are fun!

B: うん、楽しいよ！

C: No, I get dizzy.

C: いや、目が回るよ。

Teacher Note: Use this dialogue to discuss playground equipment and express likes and dislikes.

Conversation 2

A: Shall we play tag?

A: 鬼ごっこしよう？

B: Yes, let's play tag!

B: うん、一緒にしよう！

C: No, I want rest.

C: いや、休みたい。

Teacher Note: Practice inviting each other to play and giving alternative responses.

先生用メモ: 互いに遊びの誘いをしたり、断ったりする会話を練習しましょう。

Conversation 3

A: Do you want to slide?

A: 滑り台で遊ぶ？

B: Sounds fun, let's go!

B: 楽しそう、行こう！

C: Not right now, maybe later.

C: 今はやめとく、後でね。

Teacher Note: Use this dialogue to talk about different playground activities.

先生用メモ: さまざまな遊びについて会話をし、活動の選択を話し合しましょう。

A: Play ball in park?

A: 公園でボール遊ぶ？

B: Sounds great, I'm ready!

B: いいね、準備 OK！

C: I'm not in the mood.

C: そんな気分じゃないな。

Teacher Note: Discuss ideas for playing and learn to decline an invitation politely.

A: Can we have a picnic?

A: ピクニックしよう？

B: Yes, let's have a picnic.

B: うん、しよう！

C: The weather isn't great.

C: 天気が悪いね。

Teacher Note: Talk about planning outdoor activities with your friends.

2. Activity: Role Play Practice

Example Dialogue: Conversation 1

A: Do you like swings?

A: ブランコは好き？

B: Yes, they are fun!

B: うん、楽しいよ！

C: No, I get dizzy.

C: いや、目が回るよ。

Teacher Note: Encourage students to role-play the conversation with expressive gestures.

Teacher Note: Let students create their own conversation about outdoor play activities.
